Quicken 98 Deluxe installs an extension called NetManage Winsock Lib that may conflict with Snapz Pro. According to Intuit, this extension is for online banking. If you can stick with ATMs, you might consider disabling this extension. We're trying to track any potential problems with Quicken 98, and your assistance is welcomed.
