The objective of WinDom is to align three or more blocks of the same color horizontally, vertically or diagonally.

Playing the Game

WinDom is started by selecting New from the File menu or by holding down the control key and pressing the letter N.

The falling blocks may be moved left to right using the left and right arrow keys. The block may be dropped by pressing the down arrow key. The colors in the within the falling block may be rotated using the up arrow key.

Scoring

Each set of three block dropped increments the score based on their orientation. Four blocks in a row contain two groups of three; five blocks in a row contain three groups of three and so on. The scores for each group of three are awarded as follows:

Diagonally 35 points Vertically 25 points horizontally 15 points
