FILE NAME: TREK.ZIP

DESCRIPTION: Tile set depicting scenes from around the Great Lakes, and in Minnesota and Ontario.

This tile set was drawn from views of a trip from Rochester, New York to Minneapolis, Minnesota and return in September-October 1991. The trip turned out to be an extended tour, circling the Great Lakes and extending into north-eastern Ontario. We covered 3,800 miles, which prompted the name for the tile set, TREK. The tiles in the set are described below.

No. Description

Freedom Park, Bay City, Michigan.

Cliff, showing features of the Niagara Escarpment, Bruce Peninsula, between Lake Heron and Georgian Bay, Ontario, Canada.

View across Georgian Bay, with Niagara Escarpment in the distance.

Big Tub Lighthouse at the end of the Bruce Peninsula, Ontario.

Ruins, possibly of a church, in Spirit Rock Conservation Area, Bruce Peninsula, Ontario.

Friendly goose, joining us for lunch at the Wildlife Sanctuary and Island Park, Alpena, Michigan.

Fort Michilimachinac, Machinaw City, MI.

View of the Machinac Bridge, which spans the straits of Machinac between Machinaw City, Michigan and St. Ignace, Ontario.

Arch Rock, on Machinac Island in the Straits of Machinac which connect Lake Huron and Lake Michigan.

Horse and buggy on Machinac Island (motorized vehicles are prohibited on the island); Fort Mackinac at top of hill in background.

Devil's Chair rock formation, St. Croix River, Minnesota.

Brighton Beach Park, Lake Superior North of Duluth, MI.

Lake Superior, Ontario North Shore; Isle Royale in the distance.

Thunder Bay harbor, early morning; Lake Superior, Ontario Canada.

Kama Overlook, Lake Superior, Ontario.

Boat moored at Rossport Park, north shore of Lake Superior.

Ouimet Canyon, north-east of Thunder Bay, Ontario. The canyon was formed by a river diverted to a different course thousands of years ago.

Kathryn's Cove, near Agawa Bay, Lake Superior, north of Sault St. Marie.

Agawa Canyon, near Sault St. Marie, Ontario. The canyon is accessible by a rail line (daily tours in season), or by foot.
