This version fixes a problem running under Mac OS 10.2.5. Specifically, this build has removed calls to the Audio Toolbox function MusicPlayerPreroll(), which appears to break sequence playback under 10.2.5.

New features:

iPiano 2.0 is the initial release of a whole new product. MIDI input, multi-track note recording, customizable keyboard maps, the GME document format, and export of MIDI, QuickTime movie and AIFF files are just some of the new features.

Known issues:

- You may sometimes hear a "thunk" when stopping mid-playback or when starting again after having done so. This appears to be a quirk of the system sequencer; a solution is being sought for the next minor upgrade.
- The application can lag when running with an active, connected MIDI device that is also in use by another application.
- Playing a recently exported music file from a Finder window's preview while iPiano is still running has been known to cause a lag in iPiano and/or the Finder, until iPiano is quit.
