iBank is a feature rich, yet easy to use personal financial manager. It features QIF and QFX (OFX file format) import, memorized transactions, scheduled transactions, auto-fill, custom reporting and searching. iBank will also synchronize with projects from iWork.

iBank is shareware. The version you download has all of the features of a registered version, except that it will only allow for 25 transactions in any account. After you register, you will be allowed an unlimited number of transactions.

New in 1.1

- Sorting of transactions
- Scheduled transactions 4 week option
- Fixed small bug with QIF importing when fields had semi-colons
- Checks for scheduled transactions every 24 hours, as opposed to on launch
- Sub-tran values can be positive even if transaction is negative

- Can begin editing a transaction by typing command-e
- Print reports
- Auto-detect negative amounts for sub-transactions
- Add new scheduled transaction automatically causes the edit sheet to come down

- Option to backup when quitting
- Export accounts or selected transactions as QIF
- "Sync" preferences changed to "Advanced"
- Reports: include selected categories instead of ignore
- Searching greatly improved
- Fixed a few other bugs

New in 1.0.4

- Fixed bug where typing in check wouldn't set transaction type to a check
- Fixed bug where "next check #" wouldn't localize
- Transactions can now handle larger numbers
- Fixed a few other small bugs

New in 1.0.3

- Major speed improvements when tabbing through fields
- Can now tab through an entire transaction
- Import window now has an "account" column
- Can't delete reconciled transactions
- Warning is displayed when deleting transactions with the delete key
- Default transaction type for credit card is "charge"
- Default transaction type for savings is "deposit"
- Fixed bug where balance would be displayed incorrectly sometimes
- Fixed some other minor bugs

New in 1.0.2

- improved QIF import
- fixed bugs dealing with scheduled transaction
- fixed bug where new transactions wouldn't always be expanded
- trail period allows for 75 transactions
- fixed bug where reporting wouldn't subtract sub-transactions from a transaction's total
- added reconciled and non-reconciled amount fields in the account info drawer

New in 1.0.1

- improved QIF and QFX import
- imported transaction window now resembles main transaction window
- checking is spelled "chequing" for non-US users
- minor improvements to graphical reports
- fixed several bugs with scheduled transactions

- cutting and pasting a transfer transaction will break its link to its corresponding transaction
