

Apimac English-Italian Dictionary

What is English-Italian Dictionary?

English-Italian Dictionary is an application that combines all the necessary for students learning Italian: a comprehensive and up-to-date dictionary with grammatical notes; an ample phrase book containing thousand of English phrases with Italian translation; an exhaustive business dictionary helping you to write commercial letters, send emails and make phone calls in good Italian.

You can listen to the English vocabulary if you want. You can type or copy other English text into the find box and the program will read it aloud. You can copy words and phrases from the application and paste them into another document. You can easily create additional dictionaries files to supplement the dictionary and the phrase book provided with the program. You can use the program in several ways to help you to study grammar. The Italian translations include information about whether the English word is a noun, an adjective, a verb – sometimes it's all three! You can search for grammatical abbreviations, like "av" for "avverbio" and the dictionary will display dozens of English adverbs with their Italian translations.

Limitations of the unregistered version

English-Italian Dictionary is shareware and so, until registered, a reminder window appears and forces you to wait for some seconds every time you open the application, some translations are not available and the features for printing and reading text aloud are unavailable. To remove these limitations, please register your copy of the application.

You can register this software using Kagi's secure online registration service. Launch your web browser (Netscape Navigator, Internet Explorer, Opera, OmniWeb, iCab etc.) and open the web page for online registration. The URL for the page is:

for use with the shareware programs "Verbs&Nouns" and "V&N Lookup" (which you can find at the same internet site). It contains 2100 Italian nouns and allows you to practise the singular and plural forms of Italian nouns including all the common types, plus the less-common types such as lago, laghi; mancia, mance; turista, turisti; and many others. You can also use it to practise the seven forms of "the" in Italian, and the gender of nouns ending in -e. In addition you can practise the translation of nouns from Italian to English and vice versa. You can add and delete words, and create groups of similar words to practise on. You practise the words by typing the answers. Recent versions of "Verbs&Nouns" also let you practise plural forms by clicking on one of several possible answers, and you can do flash card exercises as well.
