Menu Master allows you to easily change or remove menu shortcut keys in any application. It takes about 15 seconds to learn how to use Menu Master, which saves you lots of time later because you can use the shortcuts you defined -- and not bother remembering which ones the developer of the software invented for you. Additionally, you can set shortcuts to any menu item that had no shortcuts, or remove shortcuts from menu items.
