Why are Mac OS X-generated PDFs so large? Because the operating system simply reproduces what would normally go to a printer. It doesn't look for repeated images, such as the background image repeated on each slide of PowerPoint slideshow or a company logo that appears on each page of a document. Essentially, each time an image is used in a document, it is written to the PDF, thus increasing the size of the file. Even if you use Acrobat Distiller, InDesign, or other design applications, PDF Shrink can still reduce the resolution or change the compression of the images in the PDF file.

Rubbish deletes files after they've been in the Trash for a specified period of time -- anywhere from an hour to a month. In addition, it doesn't allow you to delete files prematurely; files will be deleted on schedule only. When you drag a file to the Trash, Rubbish will intercept the file and leave an alias in the Trash. When you empty the Trash, the alias is deleted, but the original file remains intact -- Rubbish protects you from yourself. It allows you to rescue recently trashed files, and you don't have to change your workflow -- you can continue to do things the way you always have.

SlimBatteryMonitor is a replacement power gauge for Apple's Mac OS X item that tracks both laptop batteries and many UPS batteries. Multiple-battery systems (e.g., older PowerBooks) are supported as well. An icon shows power remaining, and can be accompanied by a text description (battery charge in percent, or time remaining). Colors can indicate whether the system is fully charged, charging, or on battery.
