

DE SOTO AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

The De Soto Area School District shall provide a free appropriate public education to children within the District who are identified as having a disability, in accordance with law.

Eligibility for services shall be determined by the individualized education program (IEP) team appointed by the Board of Education or its designee. Program recommendations of the IEP team shall be approved by the Board or its designee prior to implementation.

A special education policy and procedure handbook shall be developed for use in the District that outlines specific policies and procedures relating to students with disabilities. Such handbook shall meet state and federal law requirements.
