Recognizing that educational opportunities are part of the value system of a free society and a prerequisite for the opportunity to lead a full and productive life, the De Soto Area School District will provide an alternative educational program for school-age parents that will allow them to continue course work and meet the graduation requirements. "School-age parent" includes any person under the age of 21 who is not a high school graduate and is a parent, an expectant parent or a person who has been pregnant within the immediately preceding 120 days.

Students shall have an equal opportunity to participate in student activities and programs without regard to sex, pregnancy, marital or parental status.
