HIGH SCHOOL GRADING PROCEDURES

*NOTE: You should develop high school grading procedures. According to Chapter HEA 9 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, which implements state law regarding the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education scholarship, school districts operating a high school (grades 9-12) are required to establish the following written policies regarding high school grading:*

- *defining the grading system used in the high school, including whether it is weighted or unweighted,*
- *which subjects are included in the grade point average (GPA) on the official high school transcript,*
- *how pass-fail grades are incorporated into the GPA,*
- *how grades from study abroad or from alternative or home schools are incorporated into the GPA, and*
- *how to incorporate grades earned in another country by students with permanent resident status.*
