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STUDENT FUNDRAISING

Fund raising activities of any nature conducted on school property must be recommended by the respective building principal and approved by the District Administrator. This policy includes individuals and groups not directly under the control of the District.

Students under the age of 12 shall be permitted to participate in fundraising activities (i.e., door-to-door sales) only when written approval is obtained from the student's parent or guardian. Students under the age of nine, or each group containing one or more students under the age of nine must be physically accompanied by a parent or a person at least 16 years of age when working in a fundraising activity.

Collection of any funds for school activities must be recommended by the building principal, collected or directed by the principal, and approved by the District Administrator. All such funds collected and expended shall be under the financial control of the Board of Education.
