## SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Any student seeking entrance into the De Soto Area School District must reside within the established boundaries of the District, except as otherwise provided.

The District shall accept elementary and secondary transfer students from other schools in accordance with established procedures. Families who move into the District after registration are encouraged to contact the District office as soon as possible. Immunization records of students admitted to the District's elementary and secondary schools shall be presented as required by law. The administration shall verify the age and residence of children enrolled in the District schools.

The building principal shall have authority to determine the grade level at which a student shall be placed. The District Administrator, or designee, shall assign a student to a school.

Nothing in this policy shall prevent the District from denying the admission of a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another school district.

The District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This policy does not, however, prohibit the district from placing a student in a school, class, program or activity based on objective standards of individual performance or need. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
