STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

In view of the fact that a bus is an extension of the classroom, the De Soto Area School District and bus contractor shall require children to conduct themselves on the bus in a manner consistent with established standards for classroom behavior.

Students who engage in misconduct on the school bus shall be disciplined in accordance with established procedures.

The District shall distribute this policy and its implementing procedures outlining proper and improper bus behavior to all students, parents/guardians and drivers prior to the beginning of each school year.

Video Cameras

Video cameras shall be used from time to time to observe student and driver behavior. The resulting video tape shall be viewed only by the contractor and the administration. Exceptions may be made on a case by case basis and must have prior approval of the District Administrator.
