STUDENT ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND OTHER DRUG USE

The use, possession, sale or furnishing of alcohol, non-prescribed drugs, chemicals, illegal substances, or tobacco anywhere on the school premises, school bus, or during a school activity by a student at any time is prohibited. Being under the influence of alcohol, non-prescribed drugs, chemicals or illegal substances is also prohibited.

If a school official or police officer has reasonable suspicion that a student is under the influence of alcohol in violation of this policy, he/she may require the student to submit to a breathalizer test to determine the presence of alcohol. This test shall be administered by the principal or a police officer). The results of the breathalizer test or the fact that a student refused to submit to breath testing shall be used in student disciplinary proceedings.

Any violation of this policy or refusing to submit to breath testing to determine the presence of alcohol shall result in disciplinary action up to and including expulsion and referral to the police department.
