## STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS

All students admitted to the De Soto Area School District shall present immunization records as required by law. Except as otherwise provided, immunizations are required for measles, rubella, diptheria, pertussis (whooping cough), poliomyelitis, tetanus, mumps, hepatitis B, varicella and any other diseases specified by rule by the department of health and family services.

A student may be waived from the immunization requirement when the student, if an adult, or the student's parent/ guardian or legal custodian submits a written statement objecting to the immunization for reasons of health, religion or personal conviction.

The building principal or designee shall be responsible for notifying the student, parent/guardian or legal custodian of the immunization requirement and shall inform such persons in writing of their right to an immunization waiver. Building principals, or their designees, shall also be responsible for maintaining complete and up-to-date immunization records for each student attending their schools.

In cooperation with public health agencies and officials, the Board of Education shall develop and implement a plan to encourage compliance with state student immunization requirements. The plan shall be submitted to the appropriate state agency as required by law.
