BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY

The Board of Education charges employees of the De Soto Area School District with the responsibility of maintaining a high level of security for the buildings and its equipment.

The District Administrator and building principals shall establish procedures which focus attention upon minimizing fire hazards, security of records and monies, securing and locking doors and monitoring outside doors and hallways while schools are in session.

Employees are responsible for the security of their room/work area at the end of each working day. This includes specific security measures such as making certain that doors and windows are locked and all valuables are properly secured. All office and/or classroom equipment is to be securely stored within each building.
