TRANSPORTATION CONTRACTOR

The De Soto Area School District shall contract for student transportation services. {NOTE: I added this statement to provide additional guidance.}

The transportation contractor is responsible for ensuring that vehicles and drivers used in transporting students follow the rules and regulations adopted by the federal government, the Wisconsin department of motor vehicles, and the District, and that vehicles transporting students are well maintained.

The responsibility of the principal for the safety and behavior of students shall be delegated to the transportation contractor, and subsequently, the bus driver, when students are in transit, unless the students are accompanied by a chaperone or other competent adult in charge.
