



Welcome to the WinFiles CD-ROM!

Please refer to the file "readme.txt" in the root directory of the CD for complete information on the use of this CD.

If you do not already have a Web browser installed refer to the instructions contained in the readme file to install the Microsoft Internet Explorer provided on the CD-ROM. Versions are provided for both Windows 95/98 and Windows NT.

We also recommend installing WINZIP to facilitate accessing the "zip" and "tar" files on the CD. If you do not have this installed on your system already, refer to the instructions in the readme file.

The files on this disc are presented in a manner to resemble the layout and functionality of the WinFiles.com 32-bit Shareware Collection Web site at http://www.WinFiles.com.

The HTML files used to present the information must be viewed with Web browser software. You do not need an Internet connection to view them. Your Web browser can read the files files directly from the CD.

You can use any Web browser software you choose to access these files. However, the HTML files on this CD are optimized for use with Microsoft's Internet Explorer Web browser. We have included a copy of Internet Explorer on this CD.

Once your Web browser software is installed (or if you already have Web browser software installed), simply OPEN the file INDEX.HTML in the root directory of the CD. This will allow you to access all of the shareware in the collection.

Accessing the files on this CD

Once you have installed the Microsoft Internet Explorer and WinZip, you can access the WinFiles.com 32-bit Shareware Collection CD-ROM.

To access the HTML files on the CD:

- 1. Click the Start menu
- 2. Click Run
- 3. Type d:\index.html

(This assumes that your CD-ROM drive is drive D:. If your CD-ROM drive uses a different drive

letter, type that letter instead.)

The main HTML file for the WinFiles.com 32-bit Shareware Collection will appear in your Web browser's window. Use your mouse to access the desired sections of the CD.

To "download" a program from the CD, click on the program's icon. Due to copyright restrictions, some programs are not stored on this CD. In these cases, the program's icon will link you to the home Internet site of the program and attempt to download. If an Internet connection is not established, Windows 95/98 will attempt to connect to the Internet and then download the file.

If the file you selected is stored in ZIP format, Internet Explorer will automatically send the file to WinZip, where you can extract its contents to the directory of your choice (view the WinZip Help file for more information on managing ZIP files).

If the file you selected is stored in self extracting EXE format, Internet Explorer will provide you the option to Open, Save As..., or Cancel. Selecting Open will extract the contents of the self-extracting EXE file onto your Windows 95/98 desktop. Selecting Save As... will let you transfer the file from the CD to a directory of your choice, where you can then double-click the EXE file to extract it. Selecting Save As... is the recommended choice. You should create a temporary direction on your hard drive where you can save self-extracting EXE files and extract them. Once you've finished running the setup program associated with the file, you can delete the contents of the temporary directory.

You can also access the program files directly, without the need for Internet Explorer. The Zip and EXE files that correspond to each shareware section of the WinFiles.com 32-bit Shareware Collection are stored in each section's folder on the CD.
