The Internet Lexicon package is now prepared for installation. Before continuing, we'd like to alert you to the following precautions.

1. It is recommended that you use the default installation path for Internet Lexicon 1995 Freeware. This will insure the proper function of all existing and planned add-on modules to the Internet Lexicon, and save space on installation. If you don't know what "default path" means, accept the suggested installation parameters as shown on the setup screens. It should make life a touch easier)

2. If you use an uninstall utility which is designed to track your software installations, run it now so that it can track Internet Lexicon's installation and abort installation of the optional uninstall utility included with this package. This will insure a much cleaner removal of the software if you should ever need to remove it. (Remember, first and foremost this is training software. Most users outgrow it.) A dedicated uninstall program will do a more thorough job than the included utility.

Installation cleanup



Before you begin your tour, there may be some cleanup work left to do. If you did *not* change the default pre-installation directory from `C:\PCLEX` when you ran the supplied .EXE file, you have a directory containing about 1Mb of data you don't need any more. If you're a hacker, you might want to take a peek at this data. If you're not, you may as well erase it now. It's just taking up space.

You can start the software at any time by double-clicking on the Internet Lexicon icon in your PC/Internet Lexicon program group. If you want to save a copy of the original archive file (it should be called `INTLEX.EXE`), copy it to a floppy disk and erase it from your hard disk now to free up additional disk space.

Uninstall Internet Lexicon



This procedure will erase all of the files included with your Internet Lexicon package.

Please take careful note of the following cautions:

1. Once the procedure has been completed, you will be returned to Windows without warning. This program momentarily drops to the DOS level to erase the files, and you may see your screen flash momentarily while this is taking place. Ignore any error messages; they are part of a checking routine for leftover files.

2. You will have to erase icons, shortcuts and program groups manually. If you used an uninstall utility to track the installation of this software, it is recommended that you use the same utility to remove it. A dedicated uninstall utility will do a more thorough job than this simple space-saver routine.
