TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

PC-compatible computer with a 486SX-33 or higher processor
8 MB of installed RAM (minimum, 12 MB of RAM preferred)
640x480, 256-color display
MPC2-compatible CD-ROM drive
MPC2-compatible sound card with speakers or headphones
Mouse
MS-DOS operating system version 5.0 or later
Microsoft Windows version 3.1 or later
MS-DOS CD-ROM Extensions (MSCDEX) version 2.2 or later
QuickTime for Windows (version 2.01.41 or greater)

SETTING UP

You can install the *With Open Eyes* software using Program Manager or the Windows 95 Desktop. No matter which method you use, the installer will add a *With Open Eyes* icon to the Voyager group in Program Manager.

Installing the Software from Program Manager

1. Choose Run from the File menu.
2. Type **d:\setup.exe**, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
3. Click OK.
4. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

Installing the Software from Windows 95 Desktop

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Choose Run from the Start menu.
3. Type **d:\setup.exe**, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK.
5. Follow the directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

GETTING STARTED

To launch *With Open Eyes*, insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive and double-click the *With Open Eyes* icon in the Voyager group of the Program Manager.

HELP

There is extensive on-line audio help in *With Open Eyes*. To get audio help, select the ON button on the Life Preserver icon. Now place the cursor over any icon button to hear about this button. (Do not click the button to hear audio help, simply place the cursor over it.)

PERFORMANCE TIPS

Quit out of all other programs before launching *With Open Eyes*.

QuickTime for Windows

The version of QuickTime for Windows installed by *With Open Eyes* is also known as the 16-bit version. If you are using Windows 95 or later, you may already have a version of QuickTime (QuickTime 32-bit or QuickTime 3.0) installed on your computer. You must install the 16-bit version for the program *With Open Eyes* to play properly.
