### About The Program

WCLOCK presents a slightly more user-friendly time display than the standard CLOCK program supplied by Microsoft.

WCLOCK is loosely based on a program called **DAYTIME** which I once saw running on a BSD Unix system.

I wrote this using Borland C++ (although I used pure ANSI C) on an ALR BusinessVEISA model 101 sporting a **Hercules Graphics Station Card**. (And yes, the program really does look that much better on a 1024x768x256 screen.)

This is my very first Windows program. I'm enhancing it as I learn more about Windows programming. This month, I learned how to put a check mark in a menu! (I didn't say I'm learning Windows programming particularly *quickly*...)
