Installation Guide for JRE Home Inventory 3.2a

JRE Home Inventory requires Windows 3.1.

WHAT's NEW:

JREHOME.HLP (the help file) no longer resides in the windows sub-directory. The help file now resides in the JREHOME sub-directory. The user may specify a different directory for the *.DBF and *.MDX files to reside in besides the JREHOME sub-directory.

Reports may be generated using QBE (Query By Example). Multiple instances of the same report(s) can be created for NEW reports and can be shown for SAVED reports. Report separator pages based on location (house) can be produced when printing a report.

All files (*.DBF, *.MDX, and *.INI) are created dynamically by the program if they do not exist. These files are no longer shipped with the program.

CODEBASIC -60 open errors due to exceeding the maximum file handles has been eliminated. The maximum number of file handles is dynamically increased by the program.

JREHOME now works with the DOS program SHARE. We recommend running SHARE with the locks switch set to a minimum of 100. Example: SHARE.EXE /I:100

JREHOME data files may be shared on a network.

Purchase date and warranty date processing has been improved.

Various bugs created by the Visual Basic 1.00 to Visual Basic 2.00 conversion have been fixed.

Buttons have been enlarged to better support a font size of 9 points.

NEW USERS:

We recommend you create a new directory (JREHOME) and move all JRE Home Inventory files to this new directory. These files are:

NEW USERS (continued):

In Program Manager, click on <u>File</u>, then click on <u>New</u>. Choose Program Item, then click on OK. The Program Item Properties window should appear. For <u>Description</u> put any description you wish. For <u>Command Line type JREHOME.EXE</u>, including the JRE Home Inventory path. For <u>Working Directory</u>, type in the JRE Home Inventory path. Then click OK and you are ready to use JRE Home Inventory.

PREVIOUS USERS :

To upgrade you current JRE Home Inventory, please perform the following steps:

- 1. Move ALL the JRE Home Inventory files to your existing JREHOME directory.
- 2. Delete JREHOME.HLP from your WINDOWS directory.

For users of a version prior to 2.0, also do the following steps:

- 1. Delete QEX.INI from your WINDOWS directory.
- 2. Delete QEVBDBF.VBX from your existing JREHOME directory.
- 3. Delete INSTSCRL.VBX from your existing JREHOME directory.

After completing these steps, your existing JRE Home Inventory will be upgraded to the latest version.

COMPUSERVE:
