You can then take Resistance: Retribution to the big screen and play it on PS3. Simply connect your PSP to Resistance 2 on your PS3 with a USB cable and select 'Infect your

PSP'. Meanwhile, the brand-new PSP Plus function allows you to control Grayson with a DUALSHOCK® Wireless Controller. It's enabled by linking a PSP to a PS3, allowing players to play Resistance: Retribution at home or out on the road.

Resistance: Retribution features all the thrills and suspense expected of a Resistance title; with new enemies and weapons, eight-player multiplayer play with five game modes - and an advanced targeting system. Take the fight for humankind into the palm of your hand: Resistance: Retribution for PSP is out now.
