You're a star – so act like one! Developed by Sony London, the studio responsible for EyeToy, SingStar invites would-be rockstars to put their talent to the test in an entertaining social experience that will encourage even the most reticent songster to exercise their vocal chords. Encouraging players to improve their singing technique, SingStar registers the player's pitch, tone and rhythm as they sing into the USB microphone. The game then analyses how well or badly the player sings and provides feedback. Career mode allows starlets to climb the ladder, from singing in their bedroom to cutting a record, to performing for admiring fans. But for those who just wanna have fun, there's 'Pass the Mic', an entertaining party mode incorporating song challenges, duets, battles, team competitions and more! SingStar features a variety of songs from current Pop faves including Pink, Dido and The Darkness to all-time Classics like Elvis, Madonna and George Michael, allowing players to sing along with their favourite stars. All the music is fully licensed from a wide variety of artists and the game includes footage of many of the original videos for each song.
