## 1.1 F1GP Accessories disk - last updated 9 December 1995

On this disk you'll find some useful utilities for use with MicroProse Formula One Grand Prix (known as World Circuit in the USA).

Most of the programs need to be run from a Shell, rather than Workbench. Installing them to a hard drive is usually just a matter of copying the executable to where to want. All the executables have also been crunched so I can fit as much on the disk as possible. All programs should work on any Amiga (including ones with Workbench 1.x) unless otherwise stated below. Program list:

SplitTime 1.3by René Smit(also PrintSplits)AGPPerf 0.5hby Grant ReeveGPDisplay 0.02by Grant Reeve(Workbench 2.0 or higher)AGPLapTime 1.0by René Smit(also AGPLap & AGPLapMix by Grant Reeve)

Note: the above programs aren't officially endorsed by MicroProse Software.

Also included is the latest edition of Amiga F1GP Hall of Fame which is maintained by Edo Nijmeijer, and some files / information on F1GP-Ed which is distributed on a disk of its own. There is also a replacement installer for the game itself, which uses Commodore's Installer program (which isn't on this disk due to lack of space).
