

## IP Communicator install

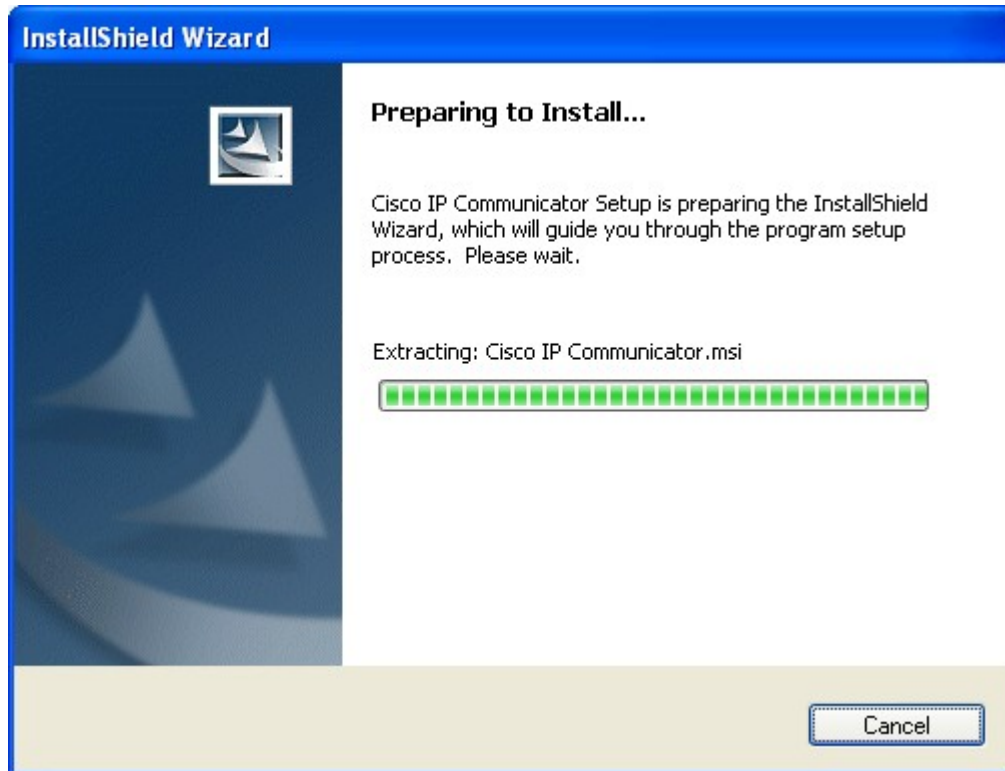
To install the IP Phone

Download the file **CiscoIPCommunicatorSetup.exe** file from

<ftp://jegftp.jacobs.com/pub/cisco/CiscoIPCommunicatorSetup.exe>

Save **CiscoIPCommunicatorSetup.exe** to a location or run to install and go through the steps below (version is now 7.0.3 but set up is still the same for 7.0.5)

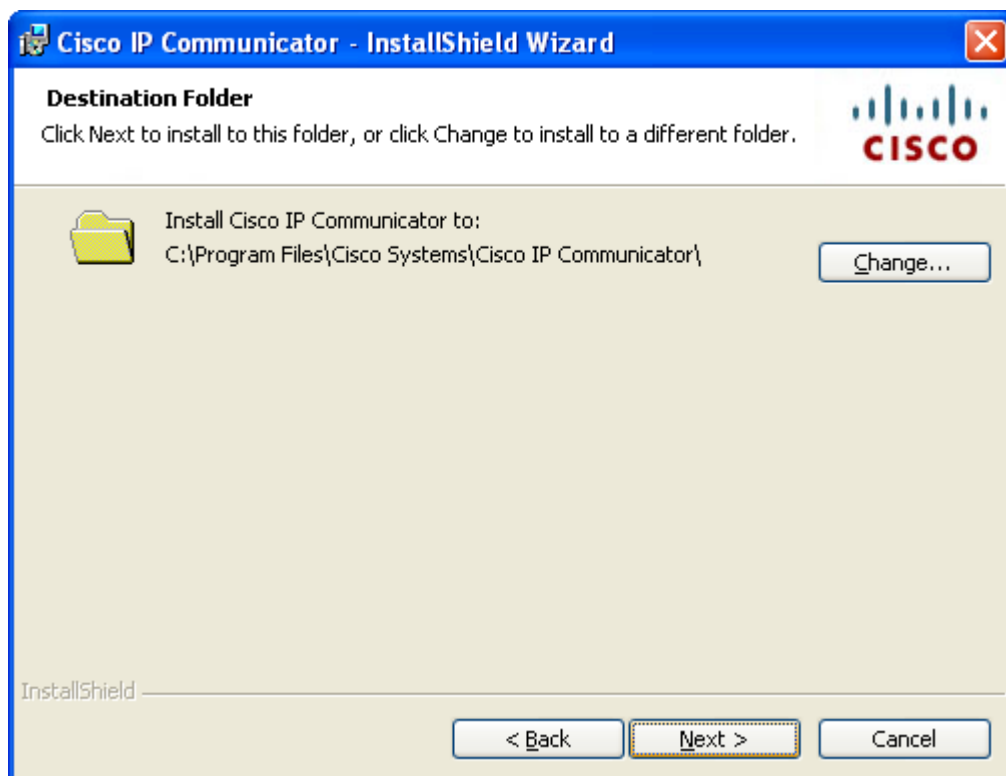
Prior to doing this install please log a ticket with Telecom so that a number and the configuration can be created on the CallManager system.



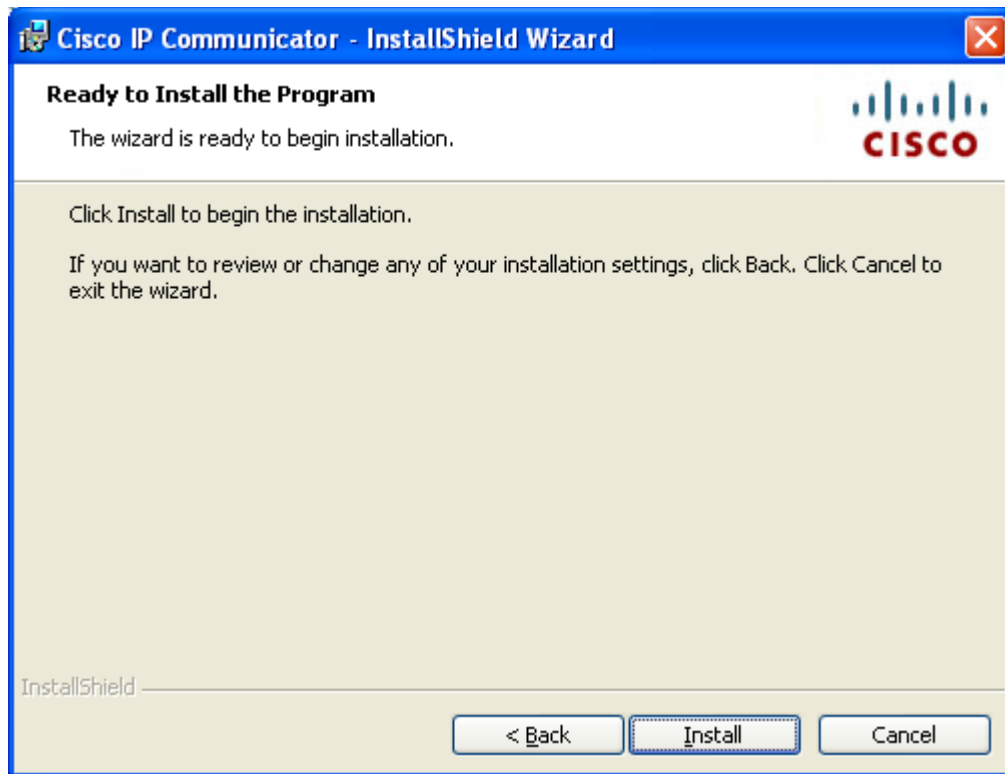
Click Next



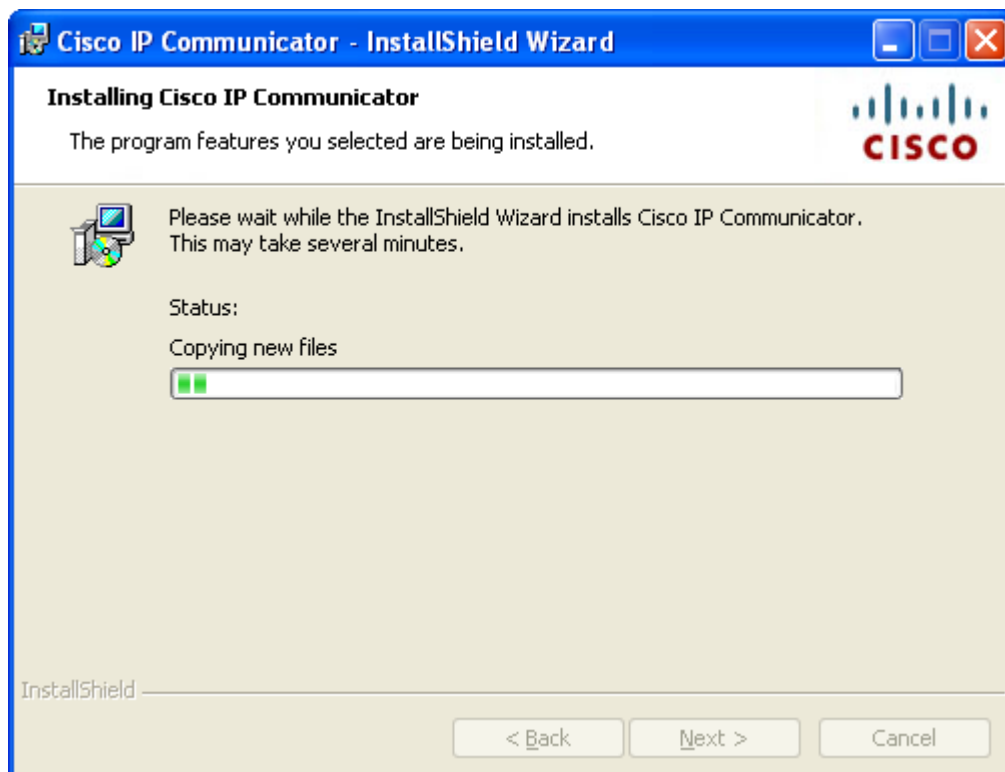
Accept licence



Accept default folder



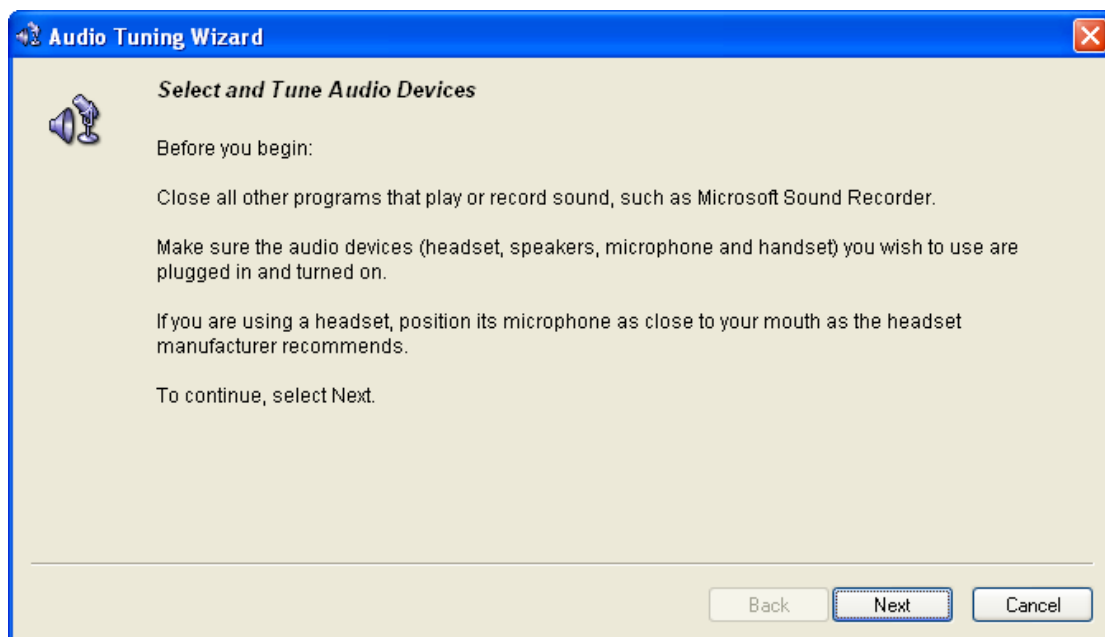
Click Install



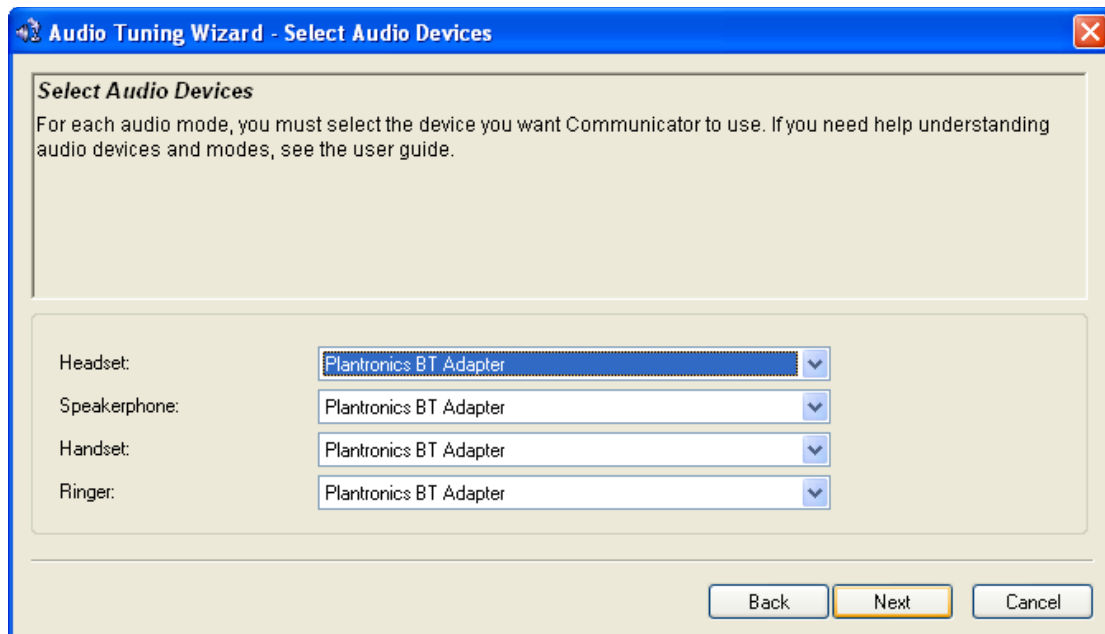


Select Finish

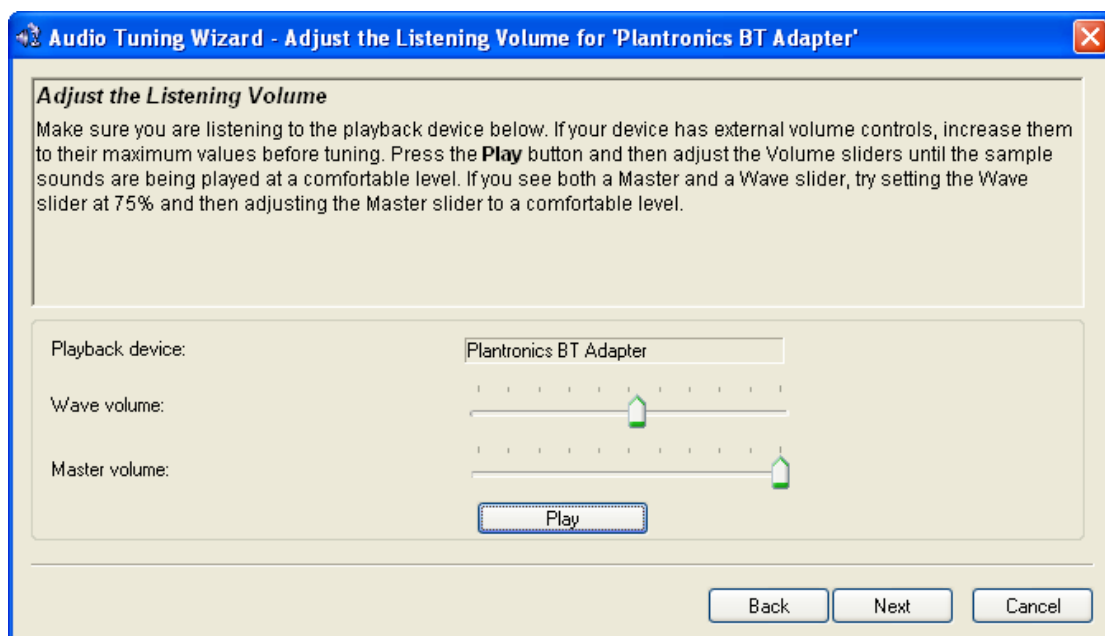
Go to Start>Programs>Cisco IP Communicator> Cisco IP Communicator  
You will run through the Audio Wizard. Ensure the audio device is plugged in



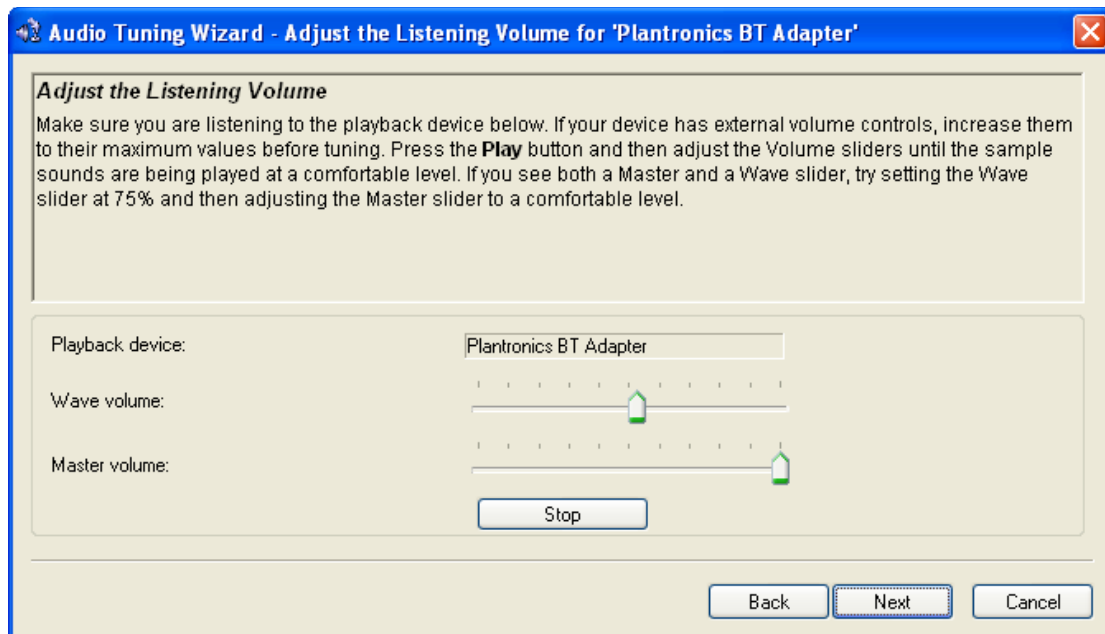
Click Next



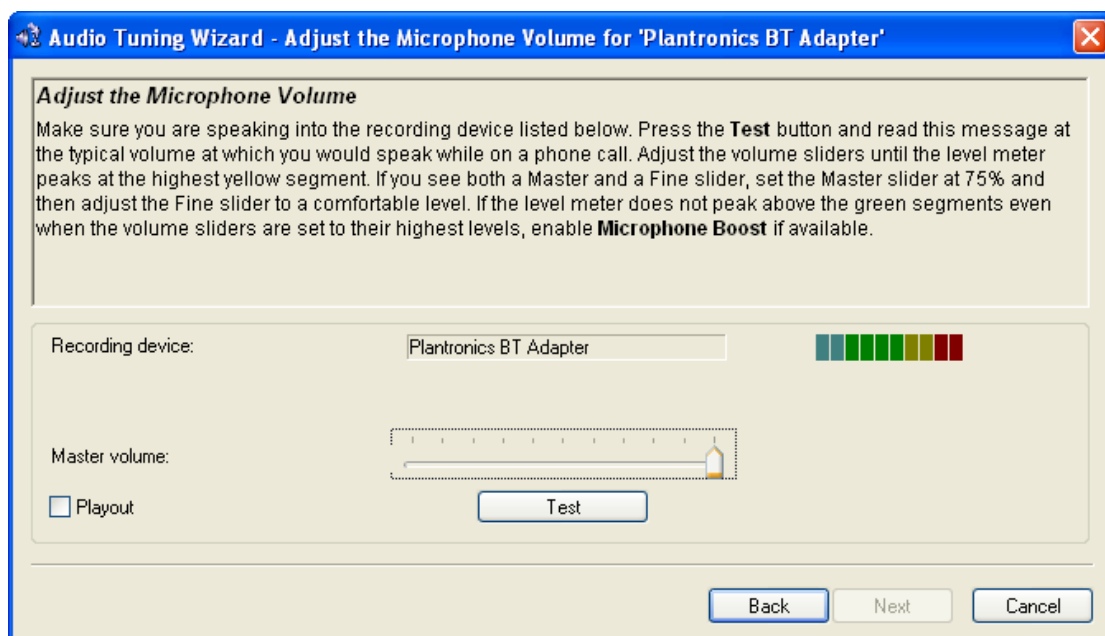
Select the device (your headset) you wish to use.



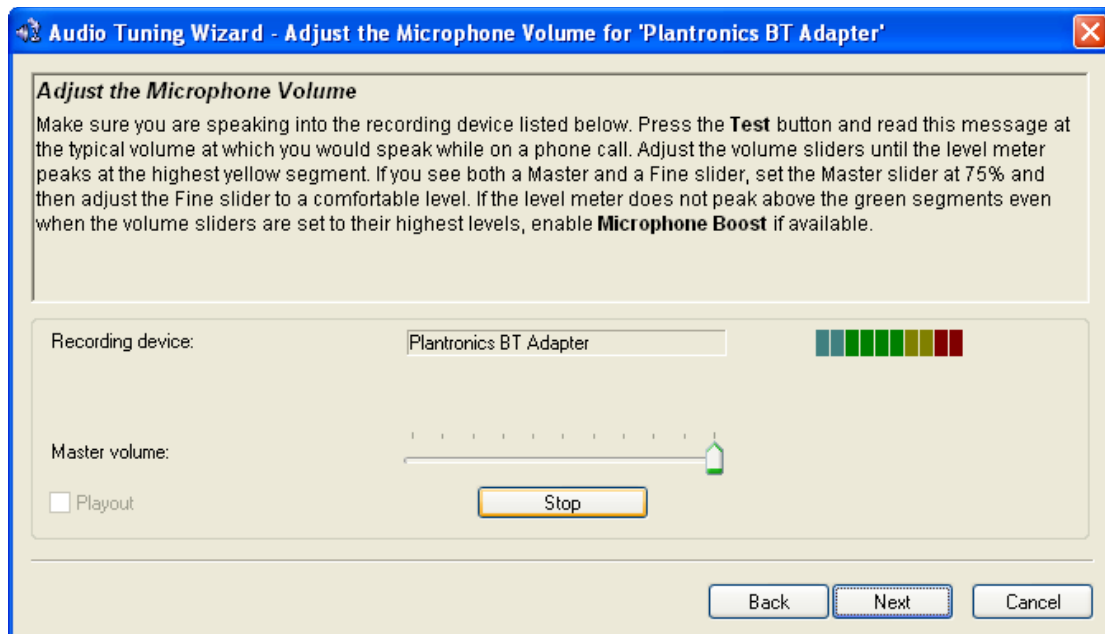
Test the playback by pressing play and adjust the volume as desired



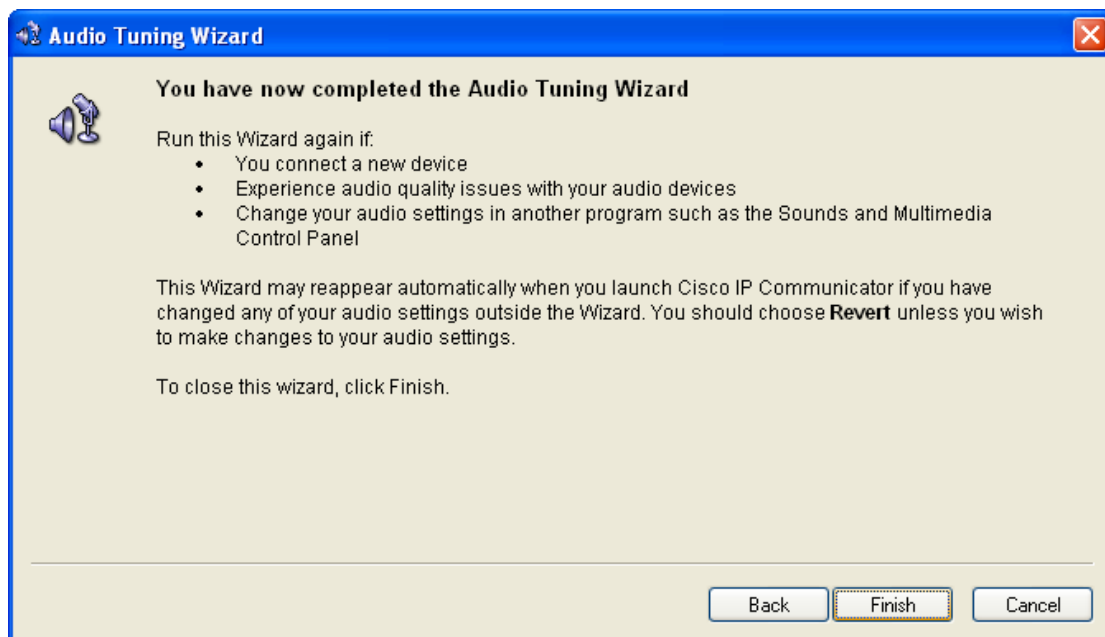
Press stop to cease the test. And press Next



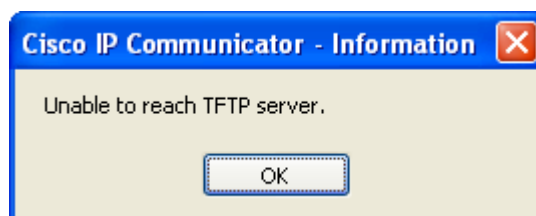
Press the Test button to Test the mic.



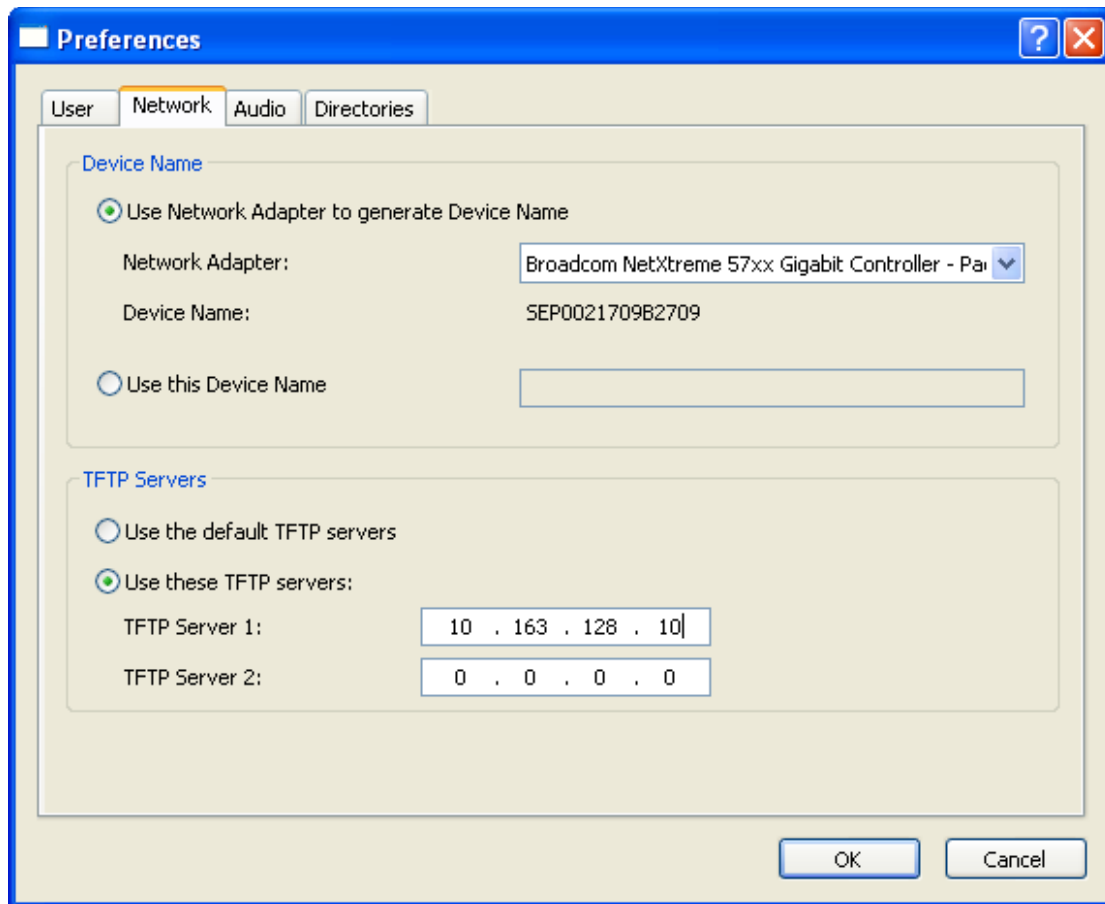
The LED should increase depending on sensitivity. Depending on your device you will have the option for a MIC boost



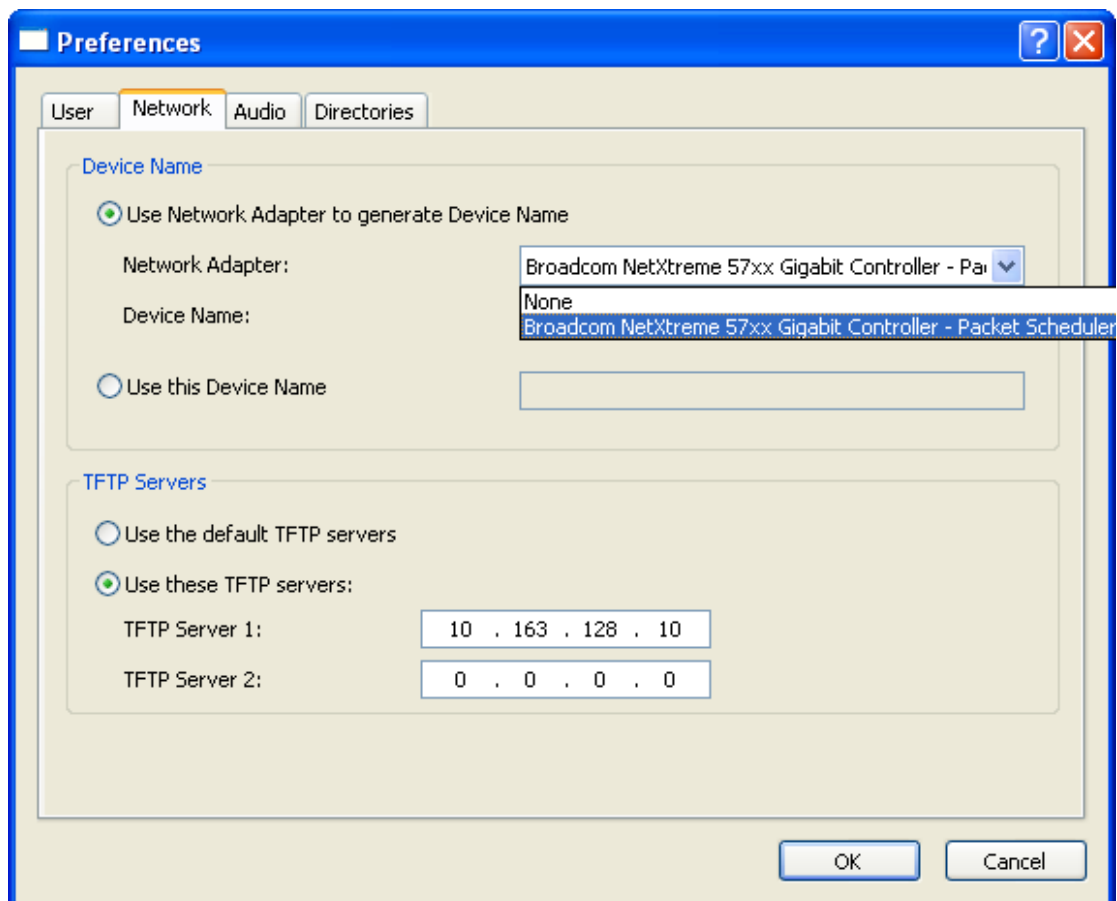
Select Finish

Instead of using the MAC address we are starting to use a method where the username is placed in the "Use this Device Name" Section

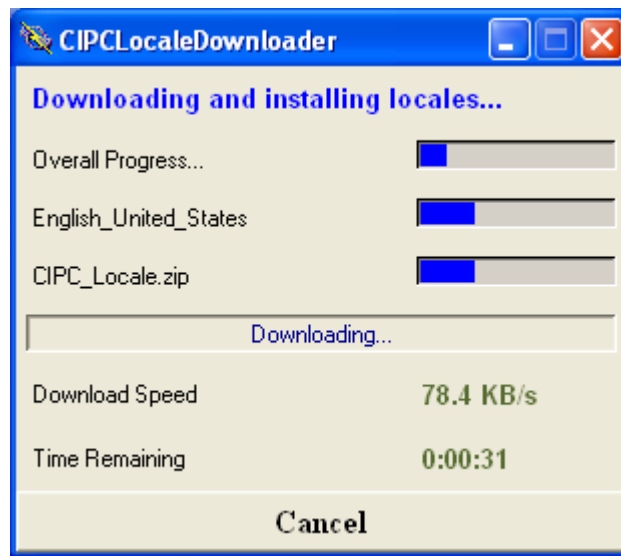


Enter the information of your TFTP server settings  
(Pasadena is 10.64.41.2) (Reading 10.160.8.2)

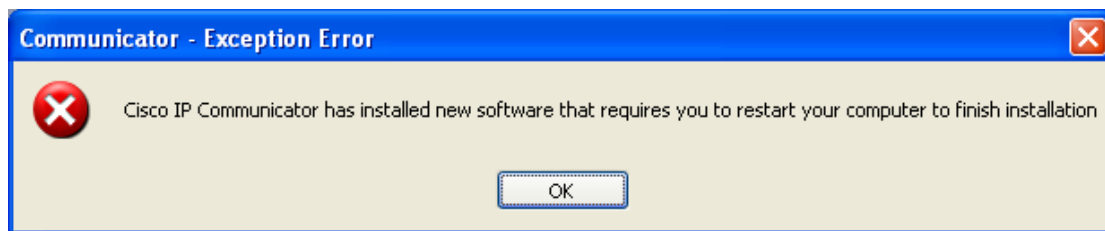
