

SAS/ACCESS[®] software is a family of individual interfaces that provide a direct and transparent link between the SAS System and various data base management systems, such as IBM's DB2, SQL/DS and IMS; Oracle Corp.'s ORACLE; Digital Equipment Corp.'s VAX Rdb/VMS; Computer Associates' CA-DATACOM; Ingres Corp's INGRES; Software AG's ADABAS; and SAS Institute's own SYSTEM 2000 Data Management Software. Data in the DBMS can be updated directly with SAS/FSP software, a tool for full-screen editing, browsing and query. Or, users can use standard Structured Query Language (SQL) to retrieve and update the data in their DBMS.
