Function Number

- 1 If you want to reboot completely your system
- 2 If you want to Restart MS-Windows

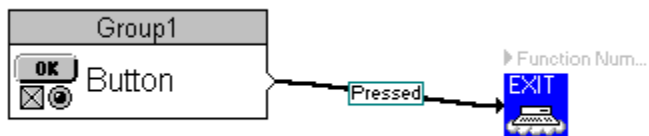
Outputs

Exit Function & Exec



This function allow you to Exit MS-Windows, Execute the Specified DOS Program and then Restart MS-Windows

Inputs

- Path and FileName

This parameter is the complete path of and Filename of the Program to execute DOS

- File Parameters

This parameter is the Argument List for the Filename of the Program to Launch DOS
