

## Operation in Playback Screen

When enjoying an album, you can not only view the photos in the album but also listen to any background music or recorded narration attached to the album, pages and photos.

The control bar will be displayed when you move the mouse pointer to the bottom of the screen.

Click on the Preferences button to arouse a dialog box for setting the playback options.

The page control buttons can locate the page you want. If you press and hold the left mouse button on the Previous Page or Next Page button for a while, the page number field at the right will keep on counting until you have reached the page you want and released the mouse button. Therefore you can select to display a specific page immediately without displaying the pages in-between. Click on the Play/Stop button to start or stop playing the pages.

The Print button allows you to print the current page immediately with normal resolution. Clicking the Set Wall Paper button sets the current page as Windows desktop background.

The Quit button allows you to exit the playback program.

When you place the mouse pointer on a photo in the album page, if the pointer changes to the shape of a speaker, it means there is a sound file attached to the photo. Click the right mouse button to play it. If the pointer changes to the shape of linking rings, that means the photo is linked to a specific page. Click the left mouse button to go to the specific page. If the pointer contains both the speaker and the linking rings, you may select to click the left or right mouse button as desired.

The annotation for each photo will be displayed in a pop-up balloon if you move the mouse pointer into the photo and stay awhile.

## Playback Preferences

When you click the Preferences button or press the [Enter] key, the following dialog box will pop up for your setting on playing back the album.

### **Full Screen Display**

This option can enlarge the display of album page to the screen size.

### **Mute**

Enabling this option disables the three options in the *Slide Show* section: *Enable Background Music* and *Enable Photo Audio*. All the sound effect will be disabled while playing back the album.

### **Auto Play on Opening**

If this option is enabled, the selected album will be automatically played back next time when you arouse the playback program.

### **Display Tooltips for Buttons**

This option turns on or off the display of on-screen tool tips for illustrating the button functions.

### **Display Photo Annotation**

This option turns on or off the display of pop-up balloons containing photo annotation.

### **Enable Background Music**

This option determines whether to play any background music assigned to the album pages.

### **Enable Photo Audio**

This option determines whether to play any audio attached to the photos.

### **Auto Replay**

When this option is on, the playback program will continue to play from the beginning after you have reached the last page.

### **Page Flipping Every**

This option sets the interval between two pages by seconds while playing back the album.

### **Save as Default**

Click this button to save the current setting as default. Usually the program will use the default setting for operation. The specified options will be loaded when you open the *Preferences* dialog box again. If you have changed the setting and select [OK], the altered setting will take effect temporarily. The default setting will be in charge next time you arouse the playback program.
