

TICKER v 1.1.3 (c) 1992 Management Systems Group

TICKER is a Windows 3.x and an MS-DOS program (two different programs, bundled together) that displays continuous streams of jokes, sayings, insults, trivia, etc. to provide you with a diversion from the hum-drum work you should be doing on your PC. Under Windows, the TICKER window will keep displaying even while you open up and work in other windows. All text items (e.g., jokes, sayings) are stored in databases, separate from the TICKER programs, and you can have as many databases as you like. Along with TICKER we provide one Sampler database containing hundreds of jokes and sayings. We also offer many other databases to registered users. Additionally, you can create your own databases with the TICKPACK utility included. The TICKER registration fee is \$15.00.

The DOS version of TICKER will run in under 256K of memory on any monitor. The Windows version will run on any machine that runs Windows.

Please refer to TICKER.MAN for installation and operating instructions.

TICKER is a shareware program and we encourage users to distribute it freely, but please distribute all of the files packaged together here as one unit. Thank you.
