Dependencies for hard- and software

The following things are needed for using WRITE:

You need AmigaOS 2.04 or higher. Some things will only work with AmigaOS 3.0 or higher. Recommended is AmigaOS 3.0/3.1.

You need a bunch of memory. WRITE will run on a bare Amiga 1200 mit 2MByte, but it is recommended to have more memory.

WRITE of course will run on a bare 68000, but here, too, having more is recommended. A 68020 should be enough, syntaxcoloring may need even more.

WRITE needs a stack of 30000 Bytes. If you make use of recursive functioncalls you should increase the stack.

Please read the documentation carefully, before using WRITE.

It can be used under the following conditions:

- * The packet must only be spread in whole.
- * Changes on any parts of this packet are forbitten except:
 1. Translations. You can add translations of the documentation or parts of it to the packet. Be carefull not to change the sense of the texts. Before starting to translate parts of the documentation please call me. Trasnlation must be handed to me and you must allow me to add this translations to future versions of WRITE.
 2. Changing of icons, tooltypes and icon-positions.
- * The price for a disk containing a demo of WRITE in any form must not be above 5DM or a equal value in any currency.

The price for a CDROM or any mass-store-media must not be more than 30DM or a equal value in any currency.
- * Fred Fish is allowed to add the demoversion to his collection.
- * It is also allowed to upload the demoversionto Aminet and to put in on AminetCDs.
- * Aslo a publication on the Meeting Pearls CDs is allowed but the complete archive should be added if possible.
