Three new menus (Commands.A, Commands.B, Commands.C)
Three new logoff screens (Goodbye.A, Goodbye.B, Goodbye.C)

All these files should be placed in your display/iso directory.

Copy the three scripts to your DOORS: directory

Now, on with the real installation.

BANNER MIXER:

Open a text editor (ie, CygnusEd) and type the following lines:

Save the file as Banner.GFX (Overwrite the original file)

LOGOFF BANNER MIXER:
