### 1.3 MiXeRz -- INSTALLATION --

Before you attempt to install anything, make :

Three new banners (Banner.A, Banner.B, Banner.C)  
Three new menus (Commands.A, Commands.B, Commands.C)  
Three new logoff screens (Goodbye.A, Goodbye.B, Goodbye.C)

All these files should be placed in your display/iso directory.

Copy the three scripts to your DOORS: directory

Now, on with the real installation .

BANNER MIXER :

Open a text editor (ie, CygnusEd) and type the following lines :

```
ÿG  
ÿDDoors:Rexx %N Doors:bxm.dd||
```

Save the file as Banner.GFX (Overwrite the original file)

LOGOFF BANNER MIXER :

Open a text editor (ie, CygnusEd) and type the following lines :

```
ÿG
```

```
ÿDDoors:Rexx %N Doors:gxm.dd||
```

Save the file as goodbye.GFX (Overwrite the original file)

MENU MIXER :

This is a bit tough.

Add the following lines to your Welcome.GFX file :

```
ÿG
```

```
ÿDDoors:Rexx %N Doors:mxm.dd||
```

Save the file.

Open the Script (mxm.dd) in the text editor, and alter the location of the menus according to the directory which has the menus is located.

ie, your conference is in a directory called FRY:, then replace all ICE: with FRY: ... And make sure the menus (commands.A .... ) are in that conference's directory (ie, FRY:display/iso/)
