# Chapter 1

## bugs

### 1.1 Known Bugs

#### Known Bugs

The following bugs (or undocumented features) are known in this release:

1. Using Gui-FTP on a PAL Hi-resolution screen, if your preferred monospace and/or proportional fonts are larger than 8 pixels high, the main window WILL NOT fit within the screen, the gadgets along the bottom and/or right of the window will be only partially displayed and will overlap the window borders.
  2. The program only recognises the long format directory listings produced by (most) UNIX operating systems. However programs or ARexx scripts can be written to convert unrecognised formats into this standard format.
  3. There appears to be a problem with VFAT (Windows 95) partitions mounted as such on a Linux host. VFAT is an extension to normal FAT partitions to allow long (upto 255 character) file names. The names may include spaces - this seems to be the problem.
  4. The ARexx command 'PUT' doesn't show the file size in the progress dialogue.
