
You can also select the last lesson which deals with the French numbers 1 - 100.


# **Pronunciation Guide Window**






# **Video Grammar Lessons**




# **Screen Resolution**



Be sure to select the screen resolution option that matches your current video resolution. This allows the program to adjust to the correct resolution.


