WBI (Web Browser Intelligence)

WBI is an electronic Internet "buddy" that keeps track of users' Internet activity and generally helps make Web browsing simpler and easier. WBI uses intelligent agent technology to reduce the Internet's complexity, helping both experienced and inexperienced users.

WBI (pronounced "webby") agent software simplifies and personalises Web use by:

- * Noticing patterns in Web browsing and suggesting shortcuts.
- * Automatically checking favourite Web pages for changes.
