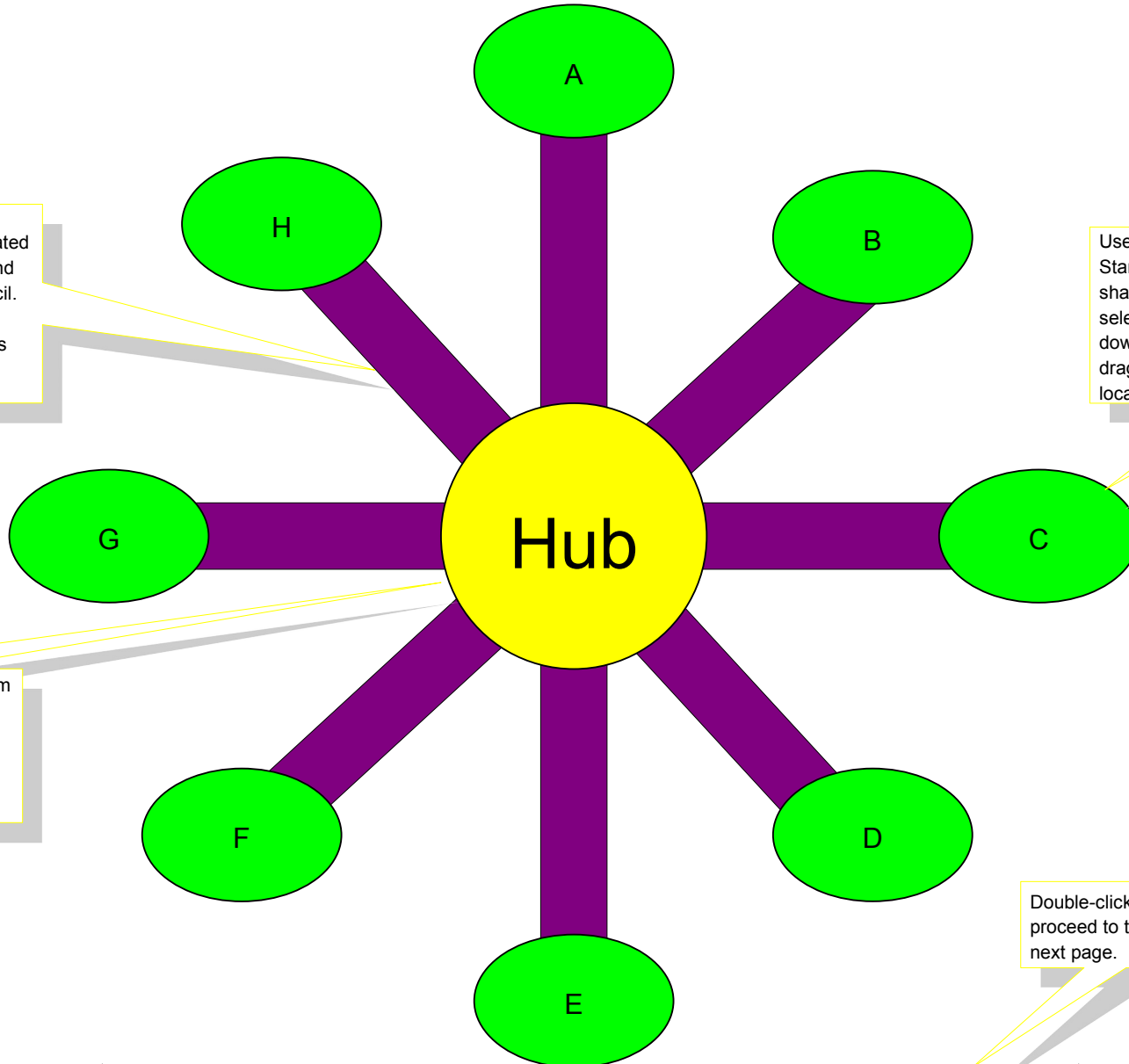


# Hub Spoke Diagram



The branches of this Hub Spoke Diagram were created with the Cross shape found in the Basic Shapes stencil. This shape can be copied and rotated as seen in this example to add more "spokes" to the diagram.

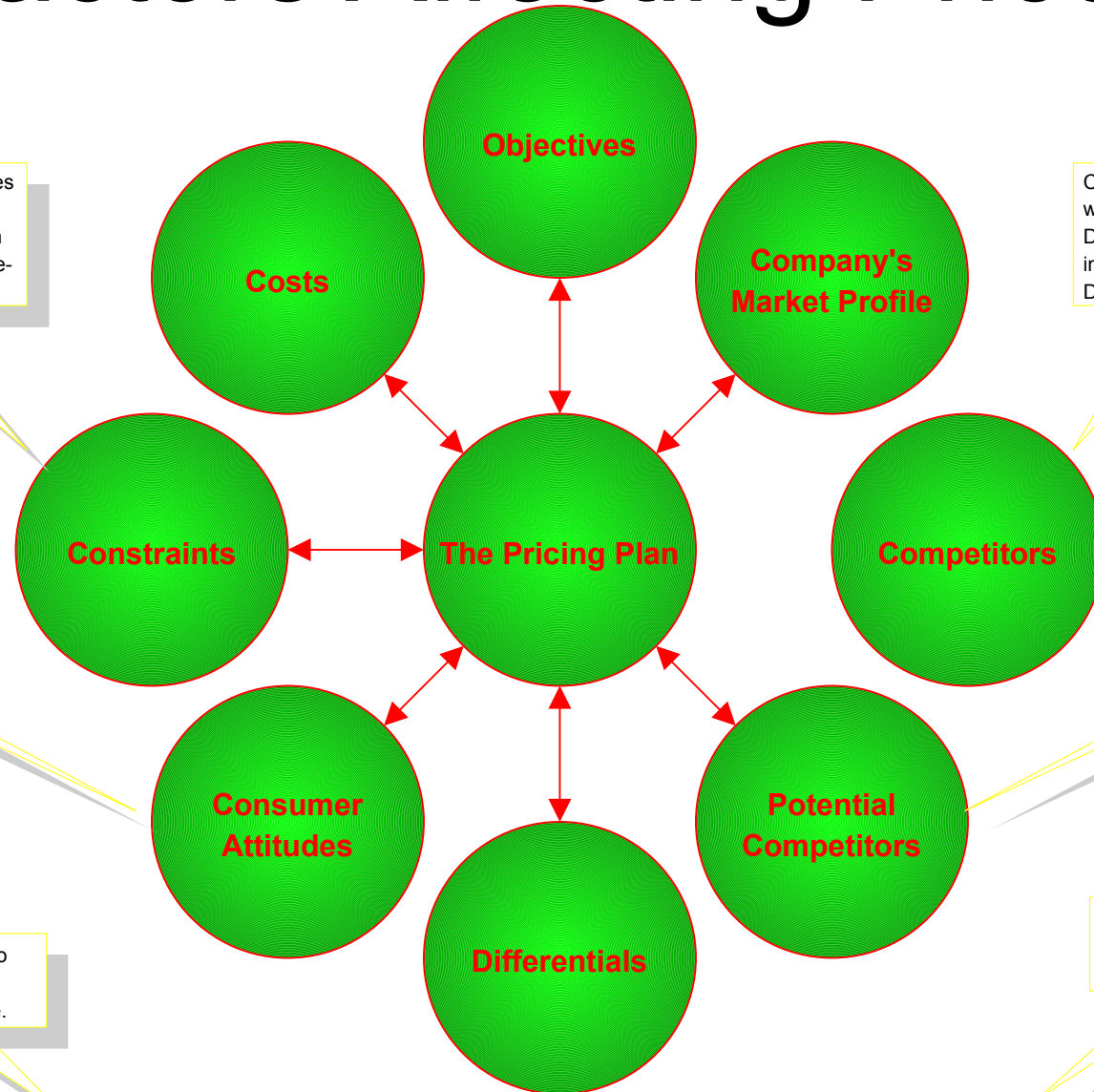
Use the Ellipse Tool on the Standard toolbar to create this shape. Then make duplicates by selecting the shape, holding down the control key, and dragging the shape to a new location.

Create a similar diagram using the Circle-Spoke Diagram shape in the Marketing Diagrams stencil. See the next page for an example.

# Factors Affecting Price



Choose the number of circles you want to include in your Circle-Spoke Diagram when you drag and drop the Circle-Spoke shape.

Although this diagram is a grouped shape, you can change the color of each shape using the Fill Color button on the Standard toolbar.

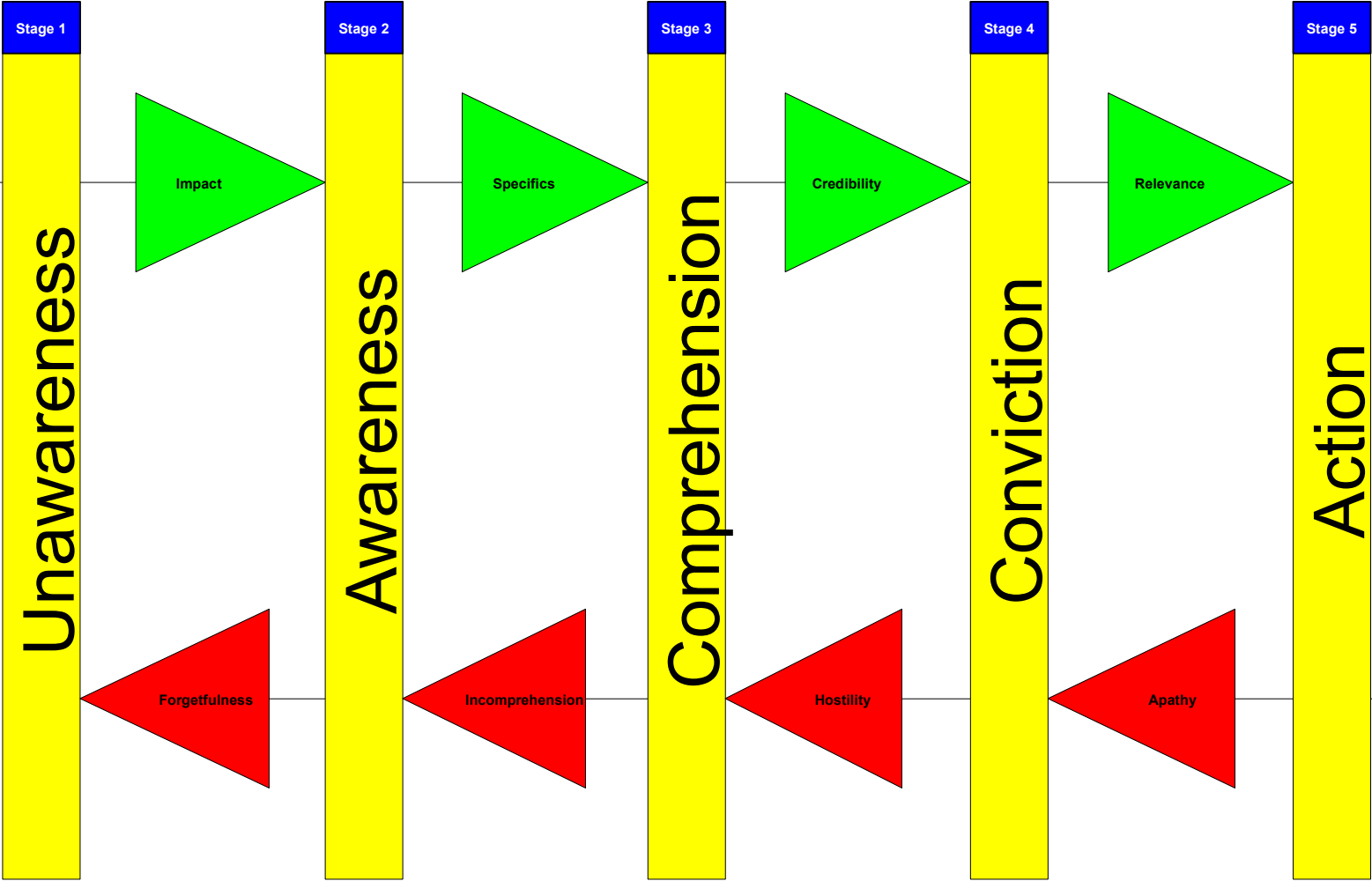
Change the fill pattern of the shapes by choosing the Fill Pattern button on the Standard toolbar.

Use the Ansoff Matrix shape located in the Marketing Diagrams stencil to create this diagram.

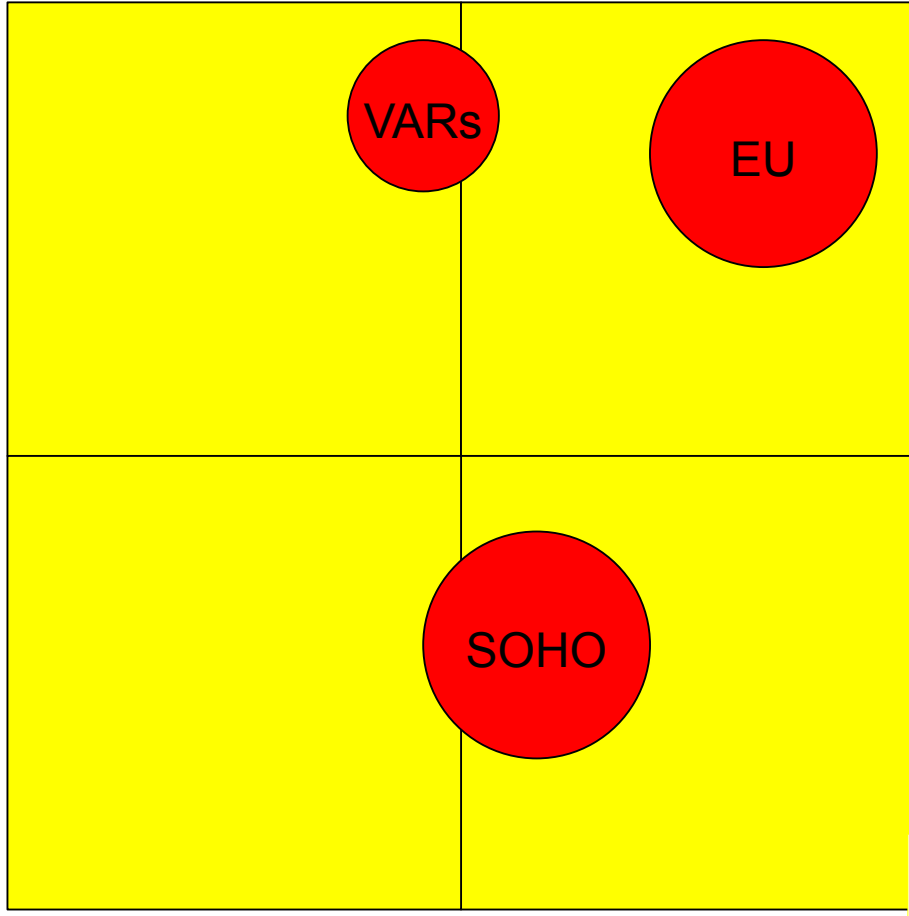
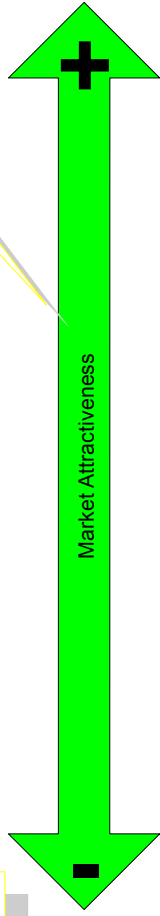

# Ansoff Matrix

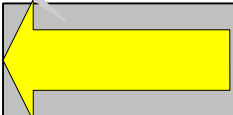


Use the 1-D Double connector found in the Connectors stencil to create this shape.

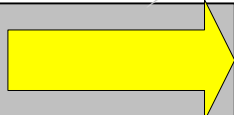


Use the Rectangle Tool on the standard toolbar to create this shape. When making duplicates, use the control key and hold down the shift key to keep the shapes aligned.

Double-click to proceed to the next page.

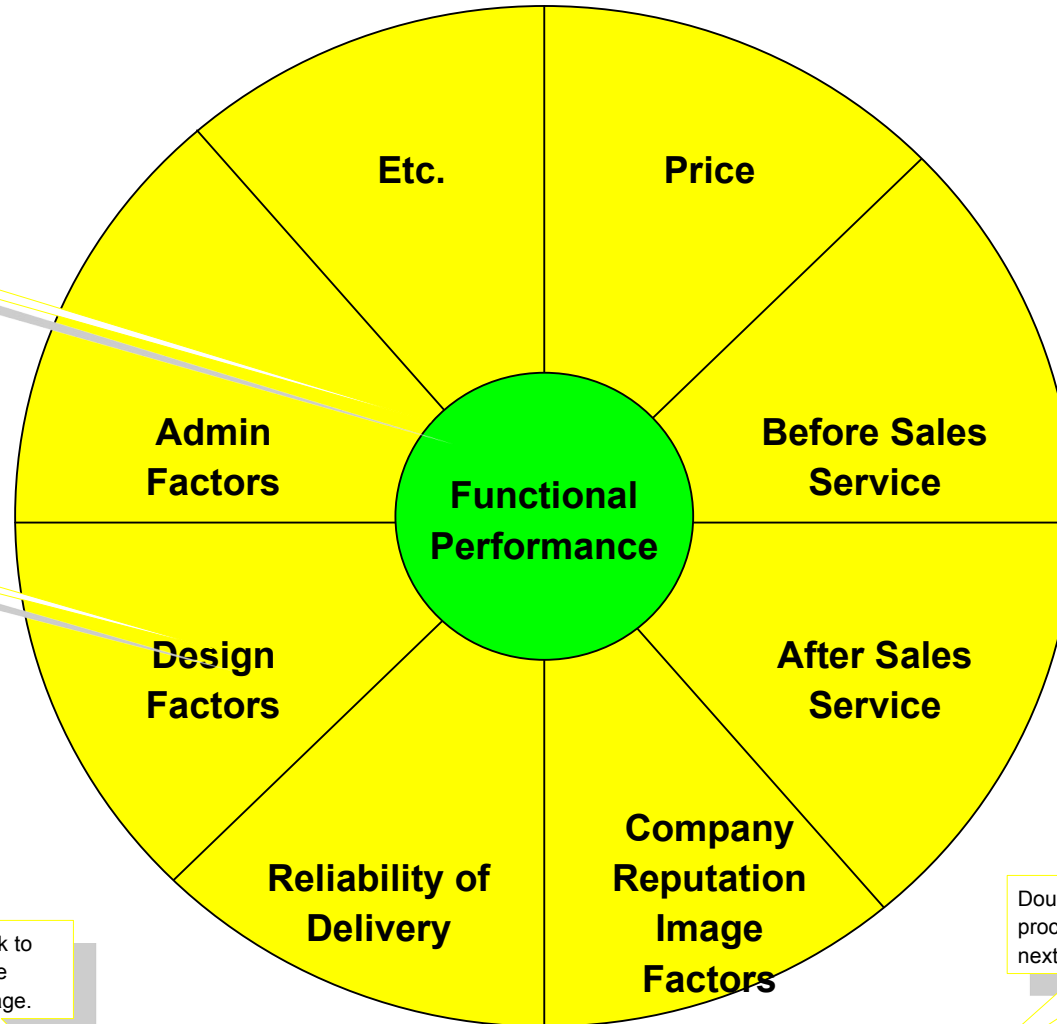


# What is a product?

Use the Ellipse Tool on the Standard toolbar to create the large circle. Divide it using the Line Tool.

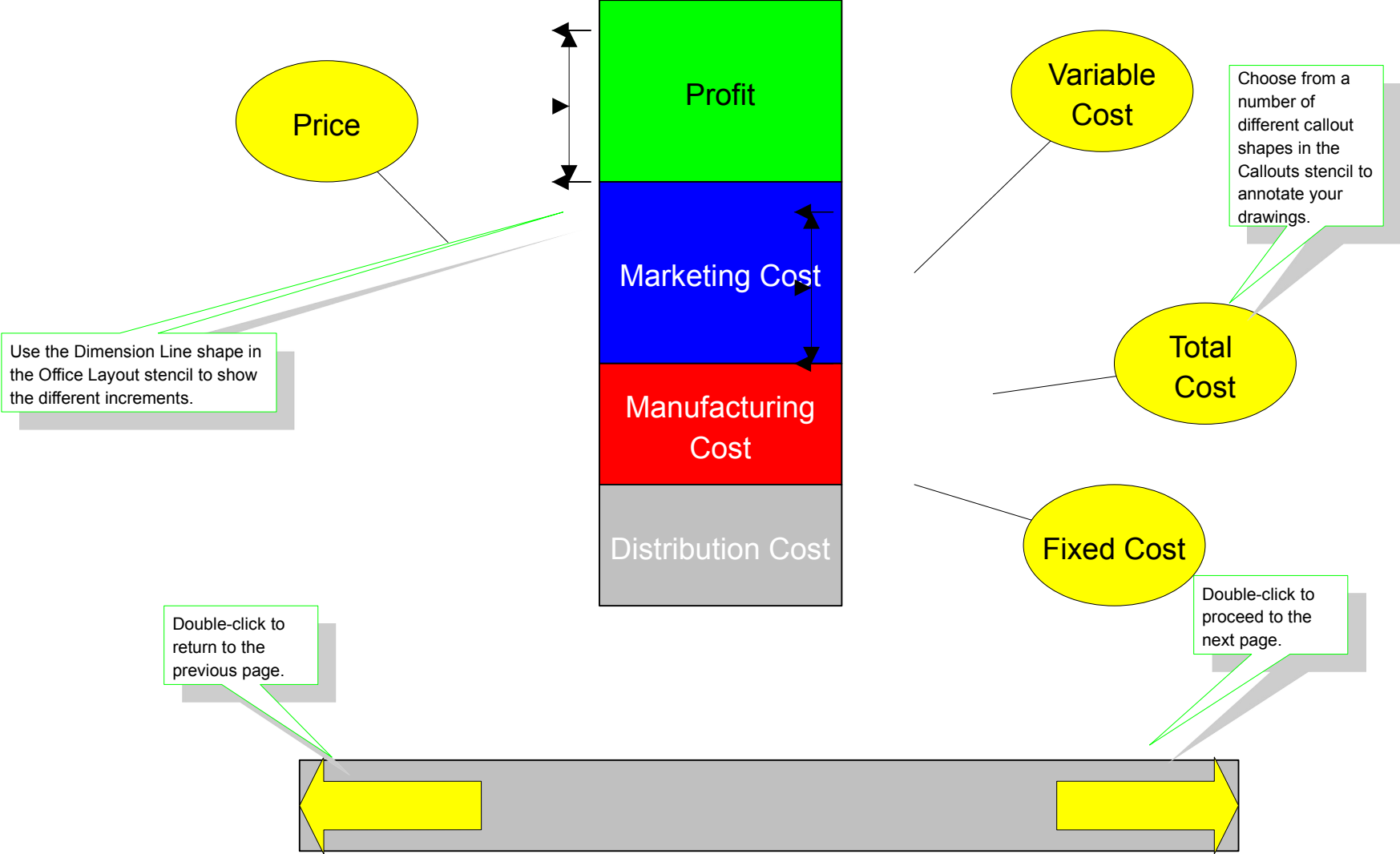


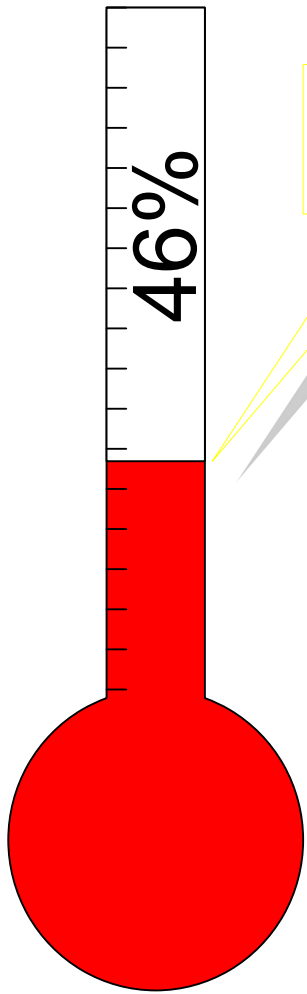

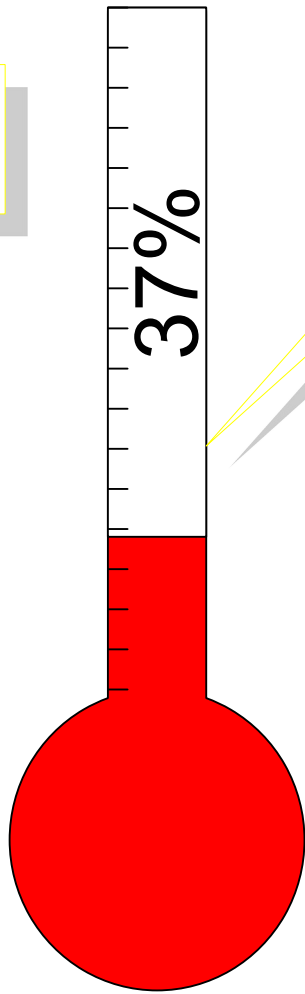


# Cost & Margin Analysis

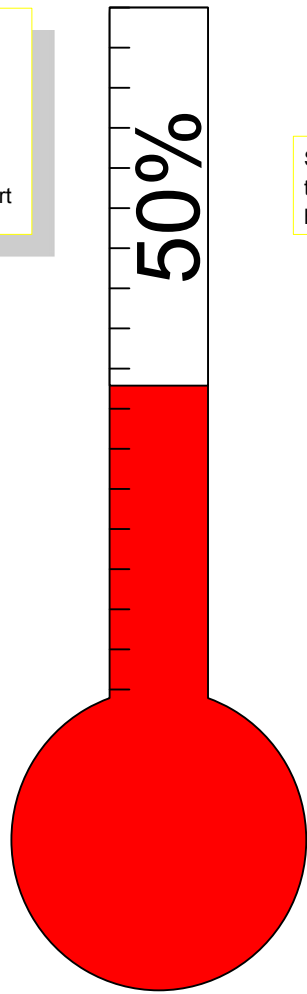




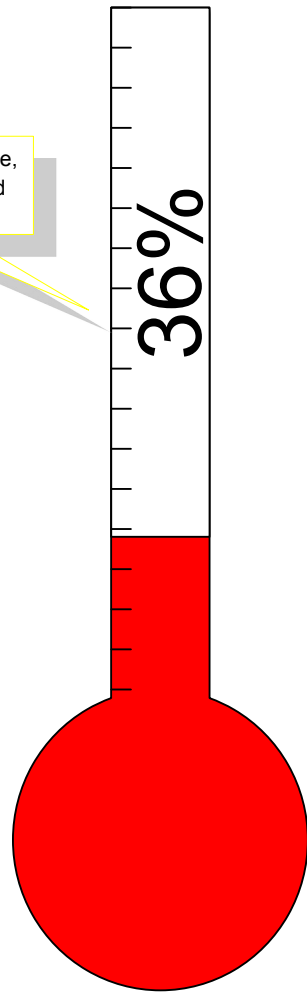
Adjust the temperature level by dragging the dimension handle.

Select the shape, then type to add horizontal text.

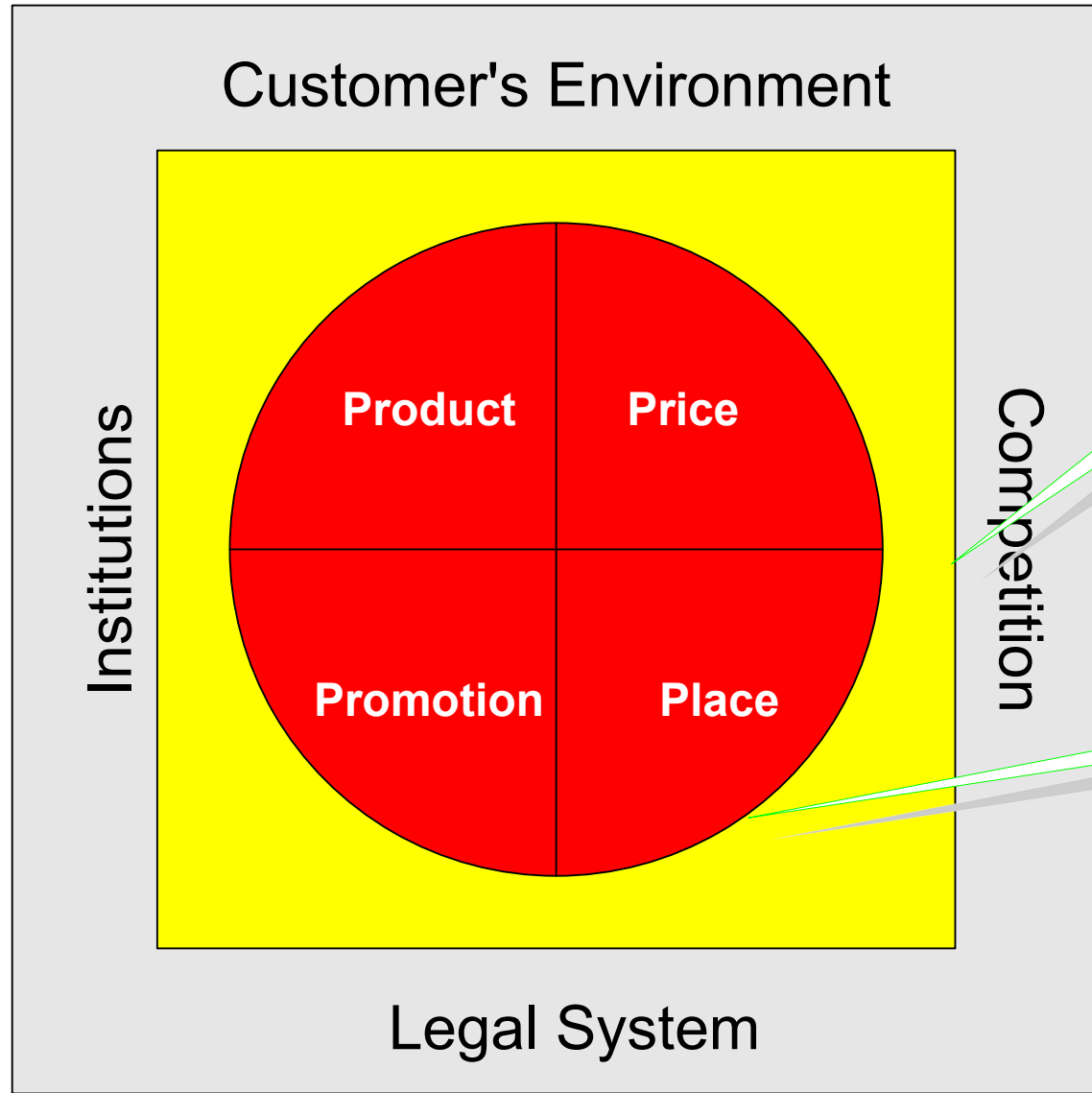

Create this shape second using the Rectangle Tool.

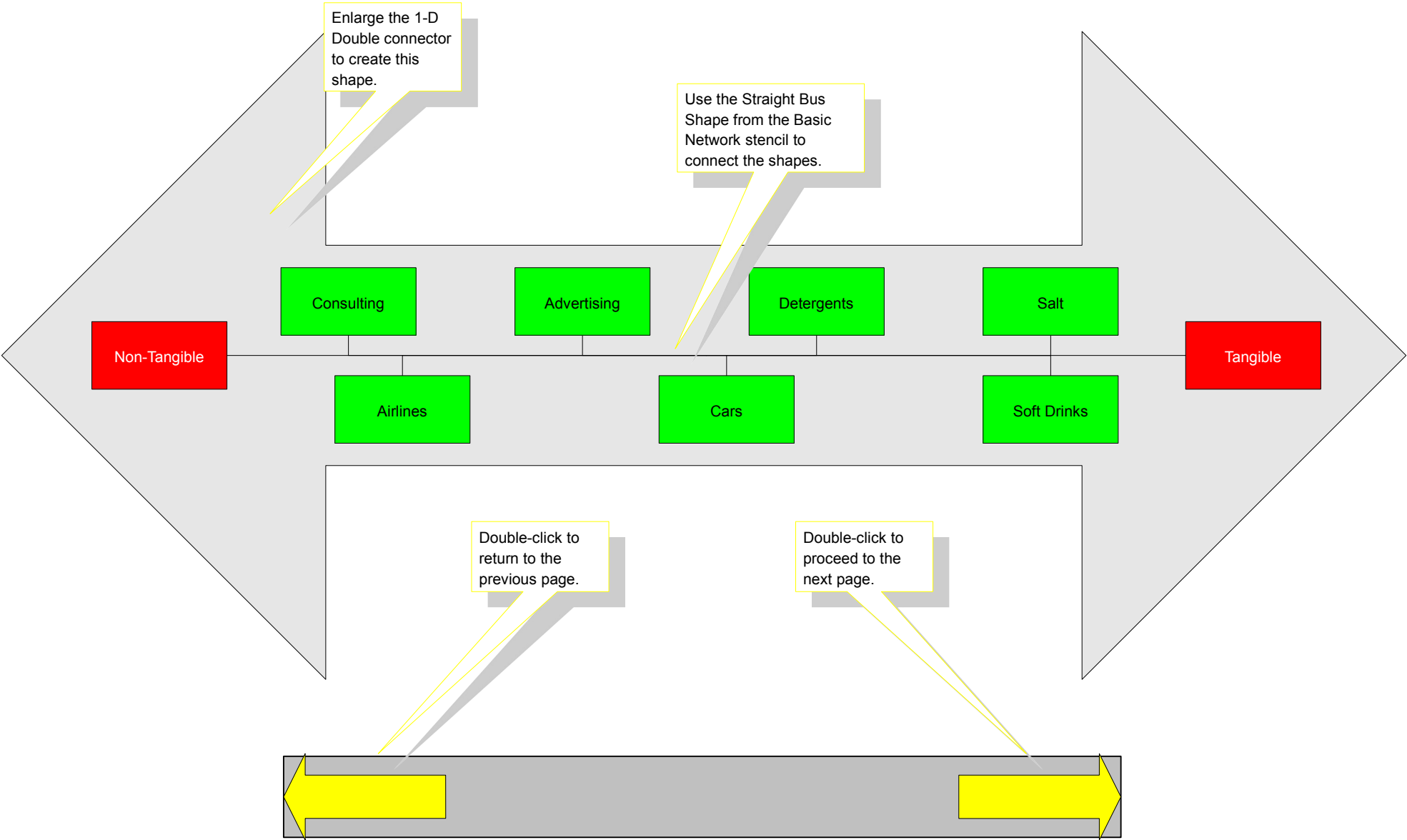
Create this shape last using the Ellipse Tool on the Standard toolbar.

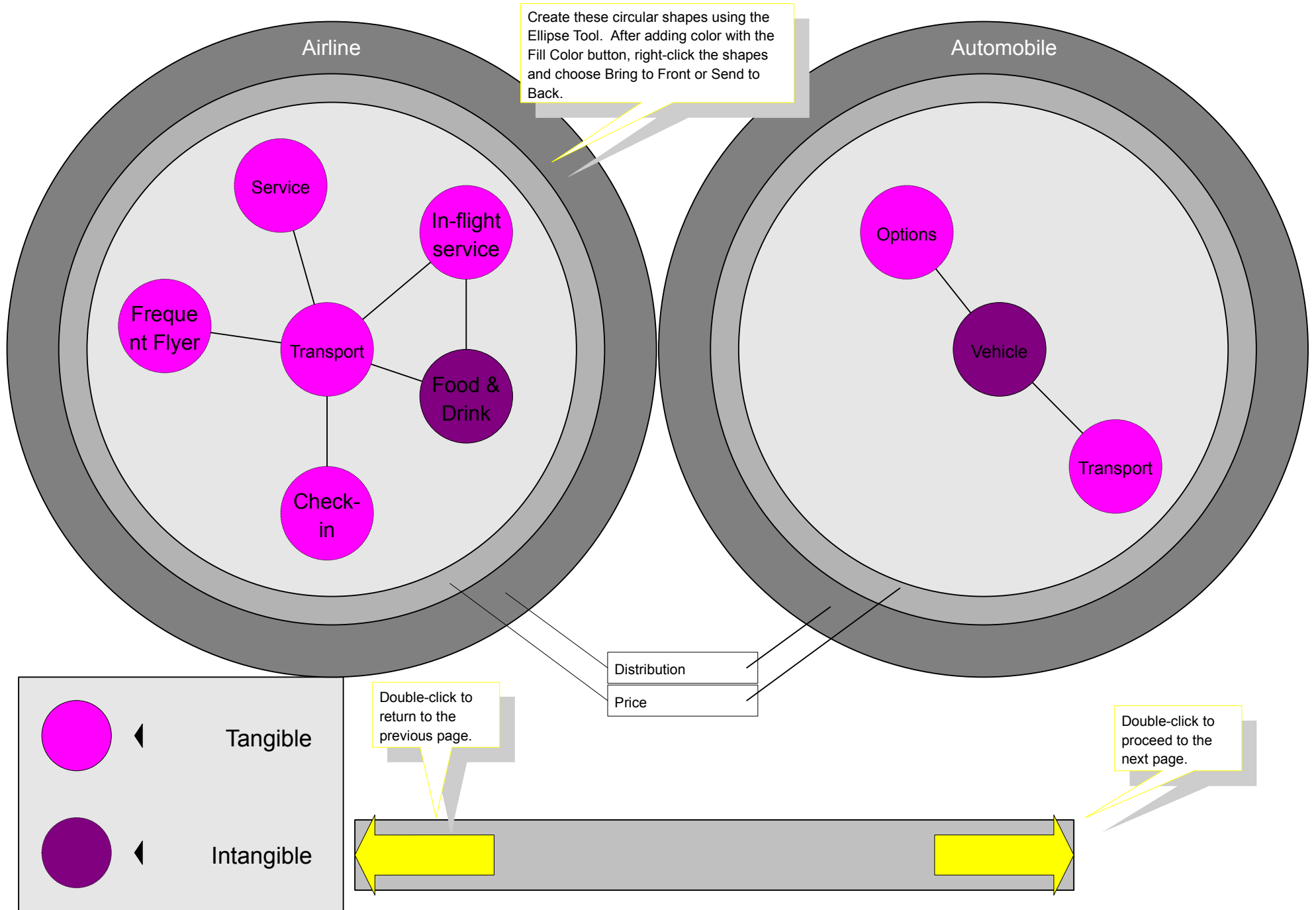

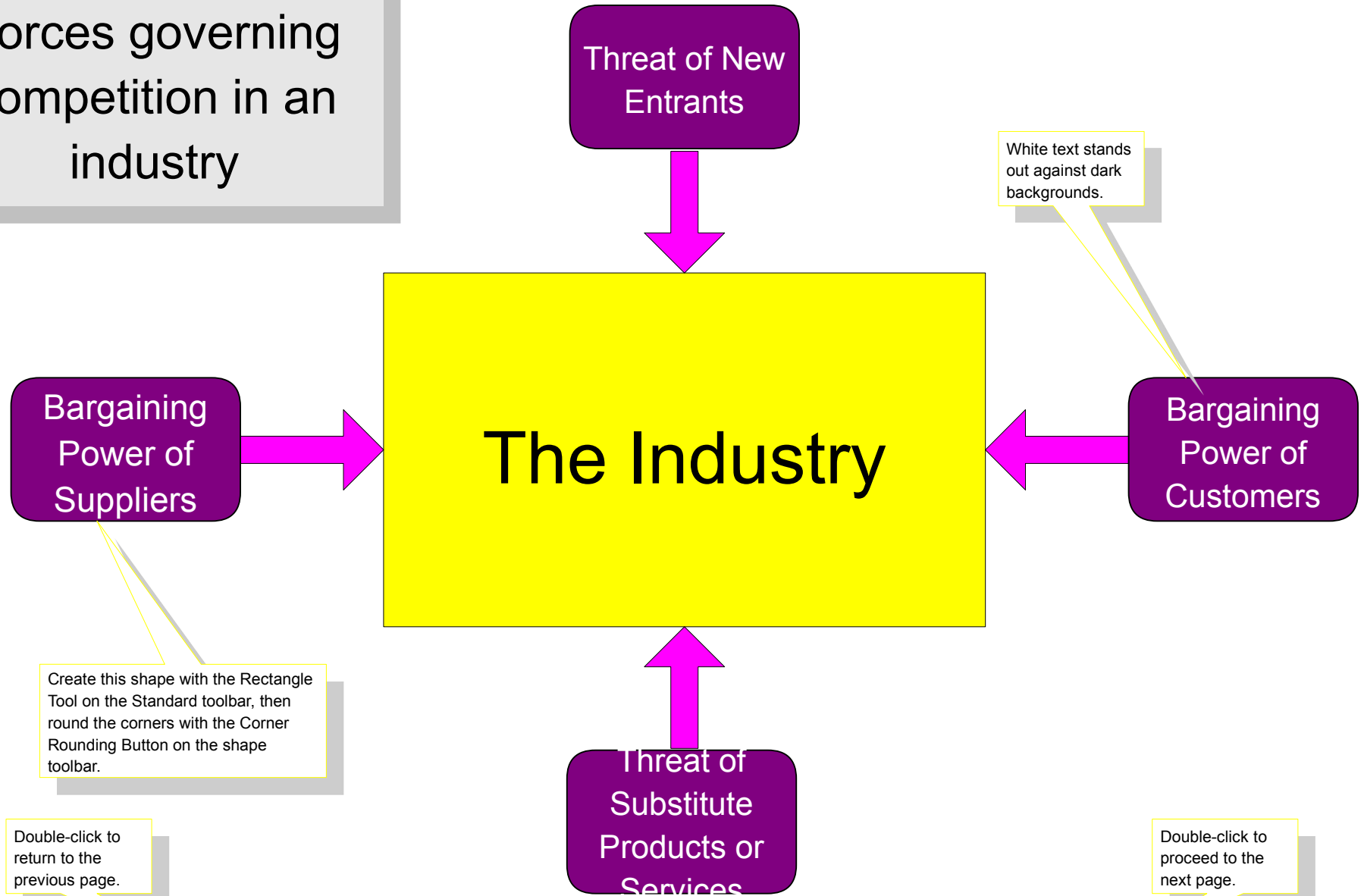

# Forces governing competition in an industry



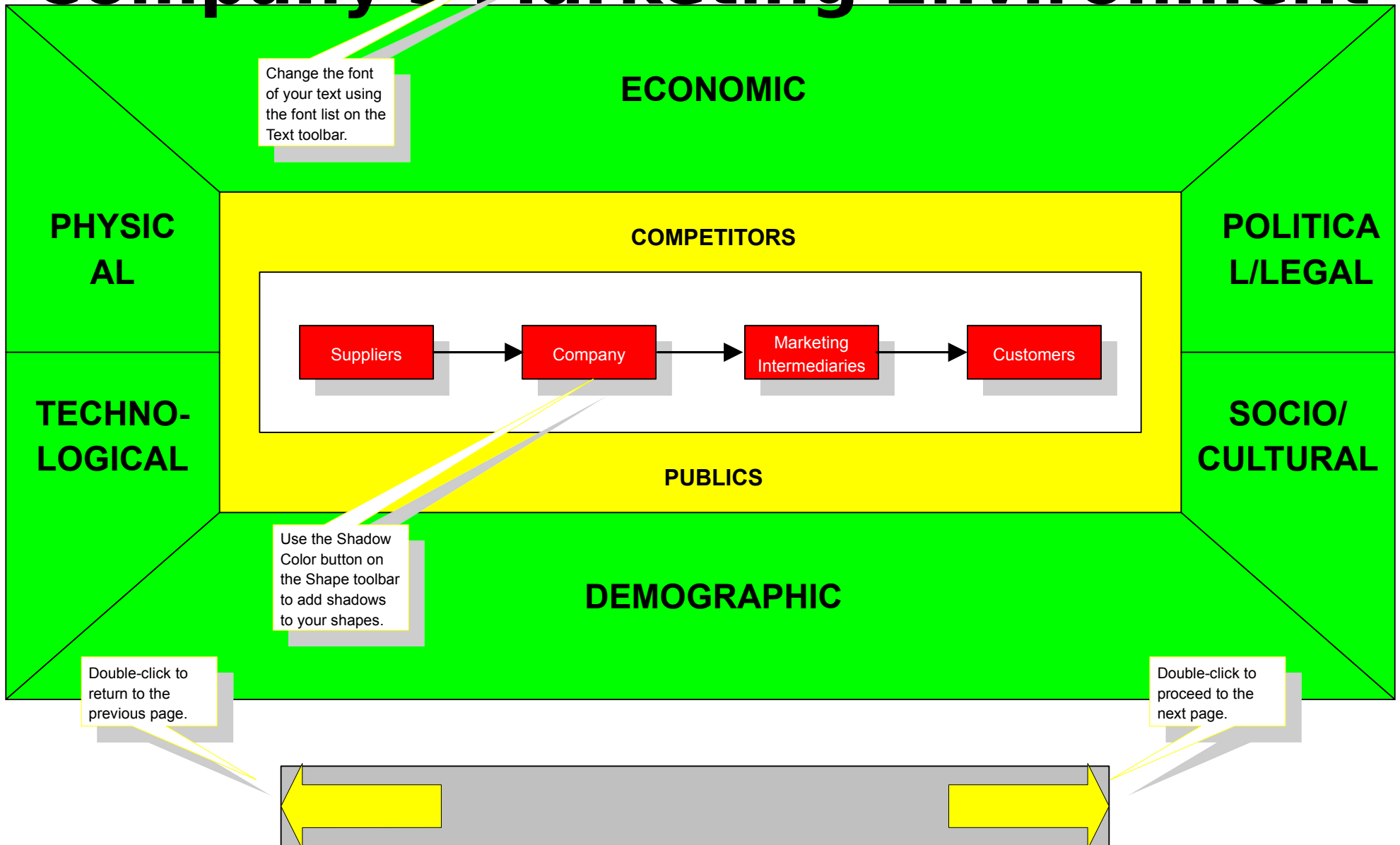

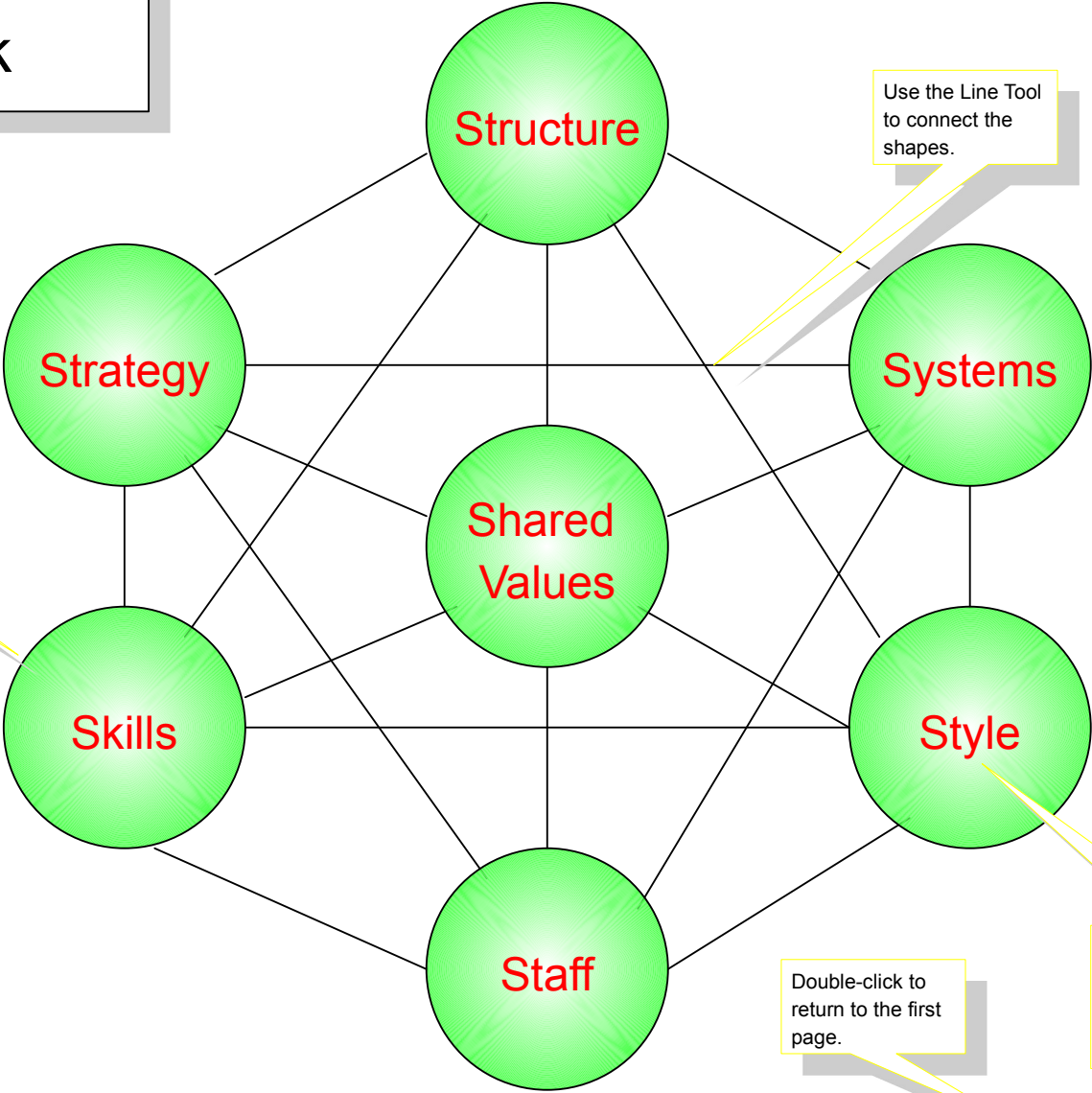
Create this shape with the Rectangle Tool on the Standard toolbar, then round the corners with the Corner Rounding Button on the shape toolbar.

# McKinsey 7-S Framework



Use the Line Tool to connect the shapes.

Fill shapes with color patterns instead of solid colors. Click the Fill Color button on the Shape toolbar.

Add color to your text by clicking the Font Color button on the Text toolbar.
