

### **Game Play**

When you start WinFish 3 you will be taken to the main fishing screen.

From here you can select all the options available in the game, and do all of your casting and reeling.

The Options screen is available also, which you can use to change to a different fishing location, and turn sounds off, and on.

To begin, select the FlyBox button, this will bring up the FLY Selection screen.

Here you can choose which type of FLY you want to fish with.

You can also choose what type of Line you want to fish with.

There a two types of line, a Floating Line, and a Sinking Line.

The Floating Line should be used with DRY flies.

The Sinking Line should be used with STREAMERS, WET FLYS, and NYMPHS.

You may want to keep an eye on the temperature to see if it is too hot for fish to hit on DRY files that are on the surface of the water.

Once your tackle is set, it's time to go fishing.

You'll be starting out by looking upstream.

You can move the scrollbar to PAN Left or PAN Right to start your casting in another area of the river.

Now just click on the Cast button.

The Line will begin to cast out from the right side of your fishing area.

Each cast will extend the line 4 feet.

Once the line has reached 8 feet or greater you will have the ability to click the Cast button again to stop the casting, and drop the line in the water.

The maximum length of line you can cast out is 40 feet.

Once your line is in the water, you will see it begin to float down stream.

Just keep letting it float.

You can reel more line out at any time.

If you click the Reel In button while the line is floating, you will have to reel your line all the way back in, and re-cast to drop your line again.

If you click the Set Hook button without a fish biting at your <u>fly</u> you will jerk your line back in, and have to re-cast.

As your line floats down stream you will some fish jump on occasion.

One of these fish just might hit your fly, so be ready.

If you do get a fish to strike your fly, be ready to click the Set Hook button.

You'll have a VERY short amount of time to set the hook!

You will also see the PAN Left, and PAN Right labels next to the scrollbar change colors from the gray background to a RED background, and the words will change to BITE. This is an extra indication of when a fish hits your fly. You will also see the fish that hits your fly, jump out of the water just as he hits your fly!

Once you have the fish on your line you'll need to reel him in. Here is where it gets tricky. While reeling the fish in, you will see two different indicators at the bottom right side of the screen, one for the tension of the fishing line, and the other is the amount of time you have left to land the fish before he spits your fly!

Be careful with the line tension, too high, and you'll break your tippet.

Don't slack off from reeling the fish in either, or you'll start losing line to him, and

once that happens, it's hard to make it up before time runs out.

You can't reel too slow or the fish will spit your fly.

Reel in too fast and you will pull the hook out of the fish's mouth, or break your tippet.

This part takes practice, but once you get the timing down you will be pulling them in one after the other.

Once you have landed a fish you need to decide what to do with him.

If he is too short you may want to throw him back. If he is ugly you may not want him either. Look at the weight and length of the fish and decide to either put him in your <u>creel</u>, or place him carefully back in the water.

Once you have put a fish in your creel, you can look in the creel by clicking the Creel button on the left side of the main screen.

In the creel you can view all the fish you have caught during the game.

You can also check the local fishing regulations by clicking the Regulations button.

The Regulations screen displays the legal lengths for all fish in WinFish and their bag limits.

We recommend not keeping short fish, or catching more than the bag limit since the

Department of WinFish and Wildlife is always on the lookout. You may get busted...

That's about all there is to playing WinFish 3, and you will soon get the hang of it and be reeling them in left and right.
