- Born 12/11/1943
- Graduated from Yale University, class of 1966
- After Yale, joined the Navy as a Swift Boat operator
- Received many decorations for valor and courage
- Provided a voice to veterans by cofounding Vietnam Veterans Of

 America
- Served four terms as a US Senator, championing jobs and health care
- Member Senate Committee On Foreign Relations for nineteen years
- Earth Summit delegate in 1992 supporting the environment

What will John Kerry do as President?

- JOBS: create 10 million jobs in the workplace by decreasing corporate taxes by 5% and eliminating incentives for outsourcing
- SMALL BUSINESS: reduce health care costs to employees, invest in research and manufacturing and remove tax burdens for small businesses that currently prevent funding and growth
- EDUCATION: increase the number of teachers by reimbursing four years of education for two years of service as a volunteer teacher in low income schools and fully-fund state education initiatives
- ENVIRONMENT: encourage energy independence by providing incentives to companies that develop alternative fuels
- HEALTH CARE: provide Senate-like health care to all Americans, cover all children's health care needs and create a national health care database to ease industry bureaucracy
- NATIONAL SECURITY: add more police, fund fire departments and improve intelligence by unifying intelligence operations
- CIVIL RIGHTS: continue the momentum of the Equal Rights Amendment and his strong support for the Employment Nondiscrimination Act through legislation AB
