

74 4D External Report™

This document describes using the 4D External Report™ program.

4D External Report™ is used to send the comments from a 4th Dimension™ external file to a text document on disk.

After launching, select 'Report on External routines file...' from the File menu. Select the externals file from the Choose File dialog and click Open. The report is generated and saved to disk.

The report is stored in the file Filename.Ext.Infos.

The header info contains the name of the external file and the current system date.

The document is formatted with the external name and parameter list followed by the comments for that external.

Example report for the file Events.Ext

This external will post an Add Subrecord event for an Included Layout.

It reads the NewSubRecord key sequence as defined in the CUST resource and posts those keys.

By default this is CMD-TAB.
