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## **About TruView**

TruView version 1.5.Copyright © Brent Beyeler 1997. All rights reserved.

This version of TruView has been released as <u>shareware</u>. The intention of the author is to allow you to evaluate the software prior to purchase.

You are entitled to use TruView for evaluation purposes only. After 30 days, you must either <u>register</u> the product or remove it from your computer.

TruView displays .BMP, .GIF, .JPG, .PCX and .TGA files. It should display all types of these files except animated GIF's. Only the first image of an animated GIF file is displayed.

TruView requires a 32-bit MS-Windows environment to run. This means either Win95, WinNT or Win 3.1 with Win32s (ver 1.30c or later) installed.

TruView does not dither high-color or true-color images for 256-color displays. Preview images are fixed at 24-bit color and will not look correct on a 256-color display. The viewing window displays the images at whatever color depth was specified in the image file so images that are already 256-color or less will display correctly on a 256-color display.

## The Main Window

### Navigating the list of files

Use a mouse click or the ARROW, HOME, END, PAGE-UP and PAGE-DOWN keys to move the cursor (the dashed box around a file name) in the list of files.

Typing the first character of a file name will move the cursor to the first file name that begins with the typed character.

You can exit TruView at any time by pressing ALT-X.

## Selecting Files

To select files use one of the following methods.

Note: You do not need to select files to view, copy or delete them.

To select or deselect files using normal file selection:

- left click on a file, dragging to select multiple files
- left click with the SHIFT key to select a range of files
- left click with the CONTROL key to add/subtract file from selected files
  - press CONTROL-A to select all files
  - press CONTROL-N to deselect all files

To select or deselect files using alternate file selection:

- left click on a file
- press SPACE
- press CONTROL-A to select all files
- press CONTROL-N to deselect all files

## Viewing Files

To view files use one of the following methods.

### With the "Use shift for selected files" option off:

To view the selected files:

- left double-click on the preview image
- press ENTER
- click the SHOW button

To view the file at the cursor:

- left double-click on a file or the preview image
- press SHIFT-ENTER
- click the SHOW button with the SHIFT key

## With the "Use shift for selected files" option on:

To view the file at the cursor:

- left double click on a file or the preview image
- press the ENTER key
- click the SHOW button

To view the selected files:

- press SHIFT-ENTER
- click the SHOW button with the SHIFT key

## Copying Files

To copy files use one of the following methods.

## With the "Use shift for selected files" option off:

To copy the selected files to another folder:

- press INSERT
- click the COPY button

To copy the file at the cursor:

- press SHIFT-INSERT
- click the COPY button with the SHIFT key

## With the "Use shift for selected files" option on:

To copy the file at the cursor:

- press INSERT
- click the COPY button

To copy the selected files to another folder:

- press SHIFT-INSERT
- click the COPY button with the SHIFT key

Note: Files cannot be renamed while copying.

## **Deleting Files**

To delete files use one of the following methods.

## With the "Use shift for selected files" option off:

To delete the selected files:

- press DELETE
- click the DELETE button

To delete the file at the cursor:

- press SHIFT-DELETE
- click the DELETE button with the SHIFT key

## With the "Use shift for selected files" option on:

To delete the file at the cursor:

- press DELETE
- click the DELETE button

To delete the selected files:

- press SHIFT-DELETE
- click the DELETE button with the SHIFT key

Note: Deleted files are sent to the recycle bin when applicable.

## The Viewing Window

Use the following keys while viewing an image.

### **ENTER or left double-click**

Show the next (or next selected) image.

### **SPACE**

Toggle the selection state of the current image and show the next (or next selected) image.

### **BACKSPACE** or right double-click

Show the previous (or previous selected) image.

### **CONTROL-F**

Return control to the main window when not viewing full screen.

### **CONTROL-S**

Save the current image as a Windows bitmap file.

### **ESCAPE** or middle double-click

Close the viewing window.

### F1

View this help file.

### **ALT-X**

Exit TruView.

If the picture is larger than the window or screen, the ARROW, HOME, END, PAGE-UP, PAGE-DOWN and scrollbars can be used to scroll the picture.

If the picture is being displayed full screen it can be scrolled by moving the mouse cursor close to the edge of the screen in addition to the keys mentioned above.

## TruView Options

Options for the main window.

### **Preview on**

This option enables the preview and image information windows.

### **Confirmations on**

This option enables the 'Are you sure?' boxes for copying and deleting files.

### Show hidden files/directories

This option includes hidden files and directories in the main window.

### Alternate file selection

This option sets the selection style of the file window, see <u>Selecting Files</u> for key definitions.

### Use shift for selected files

This option enables using the shift key to view, copy or delete selected files. The default for this option is off meaning the shift key is used to view, copy or delete a single file.

### Save drive/folder when exiting

This option enables saving the current drive and folder when exiting TruView.

#### **Auto size window**

This option enables auto-sizing the main window based on the current resolution.

### Main window sizes

One of four main window sizes can be selected if the Auto size window option is off.

Options for the viewing window.

### View full screen

This option turns on full screen viewing.

#### Auto size window

This option adjusts the size of the viewing window to best fit the image (not used when viewing full screen).

### **Shrink image to fit window**

This option adjusts the size of the image to best fit the viewing window.

### **Center image or window**

This option centers the image in the viewing window if Auto size window option is off or the full screen option is turned on, or it centers the viewing window in the screen if the Auto size window option is on and the full screen option is turned off.

### **Show image warnings**

This option displays any image decoding warnings.

## Use faster DIB display

The default for this option is off, try turning it on. If the display gets messed up when scrolling an image, turn this option back off. Some video card DIB.DRV drivers support this and some do not.

#### Slideshow timer

This option sets the delay time (in seconds) between images for slideshow display.

### **Intensity offset**

This option is a value that is added or subtraced from each pixel so the image appears lighter or darker. This option does not apply to the preview image.

If the options are not saved, any changes made will be used by this

session only. The next time you run TruView, the saved options will be used.

# The Shareware concept.

### What is Shareware

Shareware is a distribution method used to allow pre-purchase evaluation of a software product.

Shareware is not free and after the initial evaluation period the software must be registered to obtain a software licence or removed from the evaluation machine. Shareware simply represents an opportunity to "try before you buy".
