

Advent96 Registered User Information

This document is for users that have registered or are considering registering **Advent96**.

Why Register Advent96?

You gain several benefits by registering:

- You can customize all forty-two songs and play them in random order by selecting **Advent96**'s 'album play' mode—great for background music during the Christmas season.
- You can download a 'registered user package' of **Advent96** enhancements.
- You can replace our background Santa scene with any valid Windows bitmap file (*.BMP) by copying it into the **Advent96** directory (normally **C:\POWERJAM**) and naming it **ADVENT96.BMP**. There are several Christmas-oriented bitmap files on CompuServe and our web site.

Lastly, by registering your copy of **Advent96**, you help ensure that we continue creating new programs each year at Christmastime. It will take a lot of effort to develop this into the program we envision, so we hope we can afford to do so. Thanks for understanding.

Advent96 Registration Package

As described above, registered users can download extra files to enhance **Advent96**. Be sure to check this "readme" file after each **Advent96** upgrade, since the file list might expand.

The 1996 registration package consists, so far, of one archive file. Archive #1 contains **Advent96**'s forty-two carols as discrete Type 1 MIDI files, complete with karaoke-style lyrics.

To maximize the speed with which we can 'send' you the registration package, we have opted to make the files available for downloading. See **How To Process Registration Package Files** (below) for easy-to-follow instructions on processing the files.

Note: do NOT download these files unless you are (or plan to become) a registered **Advent96** user. Unregistered users will not be able to extract the files from the archive.

AC96REG1.EXE contains the first batch of registration package files. It has forty-two public domain Christmas Carols in Type 1 Standard MIDI File Format, including karaoke-style lyrics.

All carol file extensions are .MID (e.g., *All Bells in Paradise* is ALLBELLS.MID).

How to Process Registration Package Files

1. Download the registration package archive files (**AC96REG1.EXE**, **AC96REG2.EXE**, etc.) and copy them into the **Advent96** directory (normally **C:\POWERJAM**). (If you have a CD-ROM version of **Advent96**, you might already have these files.)

Note that these file(s) are not on CompuServe; they are on the **MIDI-IT! BBS** and, from Thanksgiving through Christmas, will also be on the **PowerJam Systems** web site. See **Advent96**'s online help for more details.

2. Run **Advent96** and enter (or re-enter) your Registration Information. (Each time you correctly enter your Registration Information, **Advent96** looks for all registration package files in its directory and automatically extracts them.)
 3. *Optional:* move the registration package archive files into a different directory (or delete them); this way, you won't re-process old registration package files if new ones become available.
4. *Optional:* move the unarchived registration package files (the MIDI files) into another directory on your system. Enjoy!
