I guess if I suggested we have a "tips 'n' tricks" section then I had better make a contribution, here are a few:

- 1. You can substitute a <space> for a wildcard character (\*). e.g., instead of typing: copy a:\*.\* you would type: copy a:<space>.<space>
- 2. If you have a need to modify your PATH for any reason, yet require it set back to the original at a later stage, there is a very simple way to record the current PATH. If you type the following line, it will create a batch file containing the current PATH settings. Path >OLDPATH.BAT. You can now issue a new PATH command and when you want to restore the original, just invoke the OLDPATH.BAT file.
