### How to print more than 1 page of text on a single sheet of paper

Printing with Ecopad32 is easy. After you have loaded your document, select Options/Page Compression or click on the tree icon. You will be presented with a variety of printing and page compression options. The options you set here will affect the way all documents in Ecopad32 are printed, and will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

# How to setup headers and footers

To set up headers and footers, select Options/Page Compression or click the tree icon, then select the headers/footers tab. The headers and/or footers entered here will print on all documents printed in Ecopad32, and will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

# How to display the current page number in a header or footer

To insert the current page number in a header or footer, type &P. The '&P' will be replaced in the header/footer with the current page number.

# How to display the current filename in a header or footer

To insert the current filename in a header or footer, type &F. The '&P' will be replaced in the header/footer with the current filename.

# Change the font used for screen display

To change the font used for screen display, select Options/Screen Font. The font you select here will be used for all documents you load into Ecopad32, and will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

# Change the font used for printing

To change the font used for printing, select Options/Page Compression. The font you select here will be used to print all documents you load into Ecopad32, and will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

# Change the size of the font used for printing

To change the size of the printing font, select Options/Page Compression. You can then change the size of the printing font by adjusting the "Lines per compressed page" and/or "minimum number of letters per line" controls. The point size of the printing font will change in response to your adjusting these controls.

# **Running Ecopad32 from the Command Line**

Ecoapd32 offers you a number of options when run from the command line. The basic format is:

# ecopad32 [options] [filename]

[options] can be one or more of the following in any order (separated by spaces)

/p	Prints [filename]
/p2	Prints (two sided) [filename]
/y1 /y2 /y3 /y4 /y5	Set layout to 1x1 (normal) Set layout to 1x2 Set layout to 1x4 Set layout to 2x2 Set layout to 2x4
/d1 /d2 /d3	Draw lines Draw pages Draw nothing
/zn	Set the size of the printing font to <i>n</i> points

# **Print Odd/Even Pages**

Use this command to print two sided pages. It will print odd numbered pages, pause for you to turn the paper over, and then print even numbered pages.

Tip for two sided printing: For printers that deposit pages face up you should use the following settings:

Even: First page to last Odd: Last page to first

**Print Odd Pages**Use this command to print only the odd numbered pages of the document.

**Print Even Pages**Use this command to print only the even numbered pages of the document.

# **General Printing Options**

### **Printing Order**

You can print either first page to last or last page to first. Printing last page to first can be useful if your printed ejects pages in reverse order.

Note that if you select last page to first printing, you specify the range as you normally would. For example, to print pages 4,3,2 (in that order) of document, you would specify printing *from* page 2 *to* page 4. In other words, the "from" page should always be less than or equal to the "to" page.

# **Two Sided Printing Options**

For two sided printing, you	can specify the order of	f both the odd and	even pages here.
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### File menu commands

The File menu offers the following commands:

New Creates a new document.
Open Opens an existing document.

Saves an opened document using the same file name.

Save As Saves an opened document to a specified file name.

Prints a document.

<u>Print</u> Print the selected text in a document without displaying the print

<u>Selection</u> dialog box.

<u>Print</u> Displays the document on the screen as it would appear printed.

<u>Preview</u>

<u>Print Setup</u> Selects a printer and printer connection.

Send... Sends the active document through electronic mail.

<u>Exit</u> Exits Ecopad32.

### **Edit menu commands**

The Edit menu offers the following commands:

<u>Undo</u> Reverse previous editing operation.

<u>Cut</u> Deletes data from the document and moves it to the clipboard.

Copy Copies data from the document to the clipboard.

Paste Pastes data from the clipboard into the document.

<u>Delete</u> Deletes selected text.

Select All Selects all text.

Insert TimeInsert the current time.Insert DateInsert the current date.Insert Time/DateInsert the current Time/Date.Word WrapTurns word wrap on/off.

<u>Convert Dos Text</u> Converts the contents of the current document from the DOS (OEM)

character set to the Windows (ANSI) character set.

<u>Convert Windows Text</u> Converts the contents of the current document from the Windows

(ANSI) character set to the DOS (OEM) character set.

<u>Delete</u> Delete the current line

<u>Line</u>ID\_EDIT\_DELETELINE

# **Delete Line**

Use this command to delete the current line. This command is only available if there is no text selection.

# **Insert Time**

This command will insert the current time into the document.

# **Insert Date**

This command will insert the current date into the document.

# **Search menu commands**

The search menu offers the following commands:

<u>Find</u> <u>Find Next</u>

Finds the next occurrence of the specified

<u>Replace</u> Replaces one text string with another

### View menu commands

The View menu offers the following commands:

<u>Toolbar</u> Shows or hides the toolbar. Status Bar Shows or hids the status bar.

### **Options menu commands**

The Options menu offers the following commands, which control the way Ecopad32 displays/prints all files.

<u>File Extensions</u>

Lets you select to filename

extensions which appear in the

File/Open dialog box.

<u>Display Font</u>

Lets you select the font used for

screen display.

<u>Printing Compression</u>

Lets you select the page layout and

page headers/footers.

<u>Tabs</u> Lets you select the tab size.

Auto Convert RTF Documents Automatically extract the text from

RTF documents

<u>Page Setup</u>

Lets you select page margins and

orientation.

# **Auto Convert RTF Documents**

If you check this option, when loading a Rich Text Format (RTF) document, the text will be automatically extracted from the file.

If this option is unchecked, then RTF documents will load as plain text files (so that you can edit the formatting).

# Help menu commands

The Help menu offers the following commands, which provide you assistance with this application:

Offers you an index to topics on which you can get help.
Displays the version number of **Help Topics** 

<u>About</u>

Ecopad32.

# **New command (File menu)**

Use this command to create a new document in Ecopad32.

You can open an existing document with the **Open command**.

# **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+N

# Open command (File menu)

Use this command to open an existing document.

You can create new documents with the <u>New command</u>.

# **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+O

### File Open dialog box

The following options allow you to specify which file to open:

### **File Name**

Type or select the filename you want to open. This box lists files with the extension you select in the List Files of Type box.

### **List Files of Type**

Select the type of file you want to open. Note that Ecopad32 can open only ASCII text files.

### Drives

Select the drive in which Ecopad32 stores the file that you want to open.

### Directories

Select the directory in which Ecopad32 stores the file that you want to open.

### Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

# Save command (File menu)

Use this command to save the active document to its current name and directory. When you save a document for the first time, Ecopad32 displays the <u>Save As dialog box</u> so you can name your document. If you want to change the name and directory of an existing document before you save it, choose the <u>Save As command</u>.

### **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+S

# **Save As command (File menu)**

Use this command to save and name the active document. Ecopad32 displays the  $\underline{\text{Save As}}$   $\underline{\text{dialog box}}$  so you can name your document.

To save a document with its existing name and directory, use the <u>Save command</u>.

### **Send command (File menu)**

Use this command to send the active document through electronic mail. This command presents a mail window with the active document attached to it. You may then fill out the To: field, Subject: field, etc., and add text to the body of the message if you wish. When you are finished you may click the "Send" button to send the message.

#### File Save As dialog box

The following options allow you to specify the name and location of the file you're about to save:

#### **File Name**

Type a new filename to save a document with a different name. Ecopad32 adds the extension you specify in the Save File As Type box.

#### Drives

Select the drive in which you want to store the document.

#### **Directories**

Select the directory in which you want to store the document.

#### Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

## **Select All Command (Edit menu)**

This command will select the entire document.

## Time/Date Command (Edit menu)

Inserts the current time/date into the document. If there is selected text, the selected text is replaced by the time/date.

## Word Wrap Command (Edit menu)

Use this command to turn word wrap on/off. This does not affect printing, which always uses word wrap.

## **Convert Dos Text command (Edit menu)**

This command converts DOS text, which uses the OEM character set, to Windows text, which uses the ANSI character set. This command is useful if you are loading a file which was created with a DOS text editor.

## **Convert Windows Text command (Edit Menu)**

This command converts Windows text, which uses the ANSI character set, to DOS text, which uses the OEM character set. This command is useful if you will be loading a file into a DOS text editor.

## File Extensions Command (Options menu)

The file extensions you enter here will be displayed in the File/Open dialog box. Ecopad32 will remember the extensions you enter here and will also remember the last extension you used.

# Display Font Command (Options menu)

Use this command to select the font used for screen display.

## Shortcuts

Keys: F2

**Printing Compression Command (Options menu)**Use this command to change page compression and header/footer text.

## Page Setup Command (Options menu)

Use this command to select the margins and printer you wish to print with. Note that the margins you select here apply to the physical page, and not to compressed pages.

## **Tabs Command (Options menu)**

Use this command to select the tab size (in inches) used in displaying/printing documents. You can select the default tab size by entering 0 here.

## **Page Compression Tab:**

#### Layout

Select the number of compressed pages per actual page.

#### Lines of text per compressed page

Select the number of lines you wish to print on each compressed page. This will affect the size of the font used for printing. Note that this number is approximate.

#### **Printing font**

Select the font you wish to use for printing.

#### **Page Separator**

Compressed pages can be separated by lines, boxes, or blank space. This selection you make here is displayed in the preview window.

### Print at least \_ letters per line

Select the minimum number of letters (including spaces) you wish to have on each line of the compressed pages. This will affect the size of the font used for printing. Note that this number is approximate.

### **Headers/Footers**

Select the headers/footers you wish to use for all documents in Ecopad32. The selections you make here will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

## **Tabs Dialog Box**

Select the tab size you wish to use for all documents. The selection you make here will be remembered the next time you run Ecopad32.

## **File Extensions Dialog Box**

Select the file extensions that will be displayed in the File/Open dialog box.

You can also select the default "Save" extension. This is the extension that will automatically be appended to a document when saved if you don't specify an extension. For example, if you type "mydoc" in the file save dialog, the file will be saved as "mydoc.txt".

#### **ASP Ombudsman Statement**

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## 1, 2, 3, 4 command (File menu)

Use the numbers and filenames listed at the bottom of the File menu to open the last four documents you closed. Choose the number that corresponds with the document you want to open.

### **Exit command (File menu)**

Use this command to end your Ecopad32 session. You can also use the Close command on the application Control menu. Ecopad32 prompts you to save documents with unsaved changes.

#### **Shortcuts**

Keys: ALT+F4

## Undo command (Edit menu)

Use this command to reverse the last editing action, if possible.

Shortcuts

Keys: CTRL+Z or

ALT-BACKSPACE

### **Cut command (Edit menu)**

Use this command to remove the currently selected data from the document and put it on the clipboard. This command is unavailable if there is no data currently selected.

Cutting data to the clipboard replaces the contents previously stored there.

#### **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+X

## Copy command (Edit menu)

Use this command to copy selected data onto the clipboard. This command is unavailable if there is no data currently selected.

Copying data to the clipboard replaces the contents previously stored there.

#### Shortcuts

Keys: CTRL+C

### Paste command (Edit menu)

Use this command to insert a copy of the clipboard contents at the insertion point. This command is unavailable if the clipboard is empty.

#### **Shortcuts**

Keys: CTRL+V

### **Toolbar command (View menu)**

Use this command to display and hide the Toolbar, which includes buttons for some of the most common commands in Ecopad32, such as File Open. A check mark appears next to the menu item when the Toolbar is displayed.

See  $\underline{\text{Toolbar}}$  for help on using the toolbar.

### Toolbar

The toolbar is displayed across the top of the application window, below the menu bar. The toolbar provides quick mouse access to many tools used in Ecopad32.

To hide or display the Toolbar, choose Toolbar from the View menu (ALT, V, T).

#### Status Bar command (View menu)

Use this command to display and hide the Status Bar, which describes the action to be executed by the selected menu item or depressed toolbar button, and keyboard latch state. A check mark appears next to the menu item when the Status Bar is displayed.

See <u>Status Bar</u> for help on using the status bar.

#### **Status Bar**

The status bar is displayed at the bottom of the Ecopad32 window. To display or hide the status bar, use the Status Bar command in the View menu.

The left area of the status bar describes actions of menu items as you use the arrow keys to navigate through menus. This area similarly shows messages that describe the actions of toolbar buttons as you depress them, before releasing them. If after viewing the description of the toolbar button command you wish not to execute the command, then release the mouse button while the pointer is off the toolbar button.

The right areas of the status bar indicate which of the following keys are latched down:

#### **Indicator** Description

The Caps Lock key is latched down.

The Num Lock key is latched down.

The Scroll Lock key is latched down.

## **Index command (Help menu)**

Use this command to display the opening screen of Help. From the opening screen, you can jump to step-by-step instructions for using Ecopad32 and various types of reference information.

Once you open Help, you can click the Contents button whenever you want to return to the opening screen.

# Using Help command (Help menu)

Use this command for instructions about using Help.

## About command (Help menu)

Use this command to display the copyright notice and version number of your copy of Ecopad32.

### **Context Help command**

Use the Context Help command to obtain help on some portion of Ecopad32. When you choose the Toolbar's Context Help button, the mouse pointer will change to an arrow and question mark. Then click somewhere in the Ecopad32 window, such as another Toolbar button. The Help topic will be shown for the item you clicked.

### **Shortcut**

Keys: SHIFT+F1

#### **Title Bar**

The title bar is located along the top of a window. It contains the name of the application and document.

To move the window, drag the title bar. Note: You can also move dialog boxes by dragging their title bars.

A title bar may contain the following elements:
Application Control-menu button

- Document Control-menu button
- Maximize button
- Minimize button
- Name of the application
- Name of the document
- Restore button

### **Scroll bars**

Displayed at the right and bottom edges of the document window. The scroll boxes inside the scroll bars indicate your vertical and horizontal location in the document. You can use the mouse to scroll to other parts of the document.

### **Size command (System menu)**

Use this command to display a four-headed arrow so you can size the active window with the arrow keys.



After the pointer changes to the four-headed arrow:

- 1. Press one of the DIRECTION keys (left, right, up, or down arrow key) to move the pointer to the border you want to move.
- 2. Press a DIRECTION key to move the border.
- 3. Press ENTER when the window is the size you want.

Note: This command is unavailable if you maximize the window.

#### **Shortcut**

Mouse: Drag the size bars at the corners or edges of the window.

### **Move command (Control menu)**



Keys:

Note: This command is unavailable if you maximize the window.

**Shortcut** CTRL+F7

## Minimize command (application Control menu)

Use this command to reduce the Ecopad32 window to an icon.

## Shortcut

Mouse:

Click the minimize icon on the title bar. Keys: ALT+F9

# Maximize command (System menu)

Use this command to enlarge the active window to fill the available space.

# Shortcut

Click the maximize icon on the title bar; or double-click the title bar. Keys: CTRL+F10 enlarges a document window. Mouse:

### **Close command (Control menus)**

Use this command to close the active window or dialog box.

Double-clicking a Control-menu box is the same as choosing the Close command.



Note: If you have multiple windows open for a single document, the Close command on the document Control menu closes only one window at a time. You can close all windows at once with the Close command on the File menu.

# **Restore command (Control menu)**

Use this command to return the active window to its size and position before you chose the Maximize or Minimize command.

### Switch to command (application Control menu)

Use this command to display a list of all open applications. Use this "Task List" to switch to or close an application on the list.

#### **Shortcut**

Keys: CTRL+ESC

#### **Dialog Box Options**

When you choose the Switch To command, you will be presented with a dialog box with the following options:

#### Task List

Select the application you want to switch to or close.

#### **Switch To**

Makes the selected application active.

#### **End Task**

Closes the selected application.

#### Cancel

Closes the Task List box.

#### Cascade

Arranges open applications so they overlap and you can see each title bar. This option does not affect applications reduced to icons.

#### Tile

Arranges open applications into windows that do not overlap. This option does not affect applications reduced to icons.

#### **Arrange Icons**

Arranges the icons of all minimized applications across the bottom of the screen.

# Find command (Edit menu)

Use this command to search an entire document for a word or phrase.

# Replace command (Edit menu)

Use this command to replace a word or phrase in the current document.

# Repeat command (Edit menu)

Use this command to repeat the last editing command carried out

# Shortcut

Key: F3

# Clear command (Edit menu)

This command deletes any text you have selected.

# **Modifying the Document**

Editing text in Ecopad32 is exactly like editing text in Notepad.

### **Print command (File menu)**

Use this command to print a document. This command presents a <u>Print dialog box</u>, where you may specify the range of pages to be printed, the number of copies, the destination printer, and other printer setup options.

### **Shortcuts**

Toolbar:

Keys: CTRL+P

### Print dialog box

The following options allow you to specify how the document should be printed:

#### **Printer**

This is the active printer and printer connection. Choose the Setup option to change the printer and printer connection.

#### Setup

Displays a <u>Print Setup dialog box</u>, so you can select a printer and printer connection.

#### **Print Range**

Specify the pages you want to print:

**All** Prints the entire document.

**Selectio** Prints the currently selected text.

n

**Pages** Prints the range of pages you specify in the From and To boxes.

### Copies

Specify the number of copies you want to print for the above page range.

### **Collate Copies**

Prints copies in page number order, instead of separated multiple copies of each page.

#### **Print Quality**

Select the quality of the printing. Generally, lower quality printing takes less time to produce.

# **Print Progress Dialog**

The Printing dialog box is shown during the time that Ecopad32 is sending output to the printer. The page number indicates the progress of the printing.

To abort printing, choose Cancel.

### **Print Preview command (File menu)**

Use this command to display the active document as it would appear when printed. When you choose this command, the main window will be replaced with a print preview window in which one or two pages will be displayed in their printed format. The <u>print preview toolbar</u> offers you options to view either one or two pages at a time; move back and forth through the document; zoom in and out of pages; and initiate a print job.

### **Print Preview toolbar**

The print preview toolbar offers you the following options:

### Print

Bring up the print dialog box, to start a print job.

### **Next Page**

Preview the next printed page.

#### **Prev Page**

Preview the previous printed page.

### One Page / Two Page

Preview one or two printed pages at a time.

#### Zoom In

Take a closer look at the printed page.

### **Zoom Out**

Take a larger look at the printed page.

#### Close

Return from print preview to the editing window.

# **Print Setup command (File menu)**

Use this command to select a printer and a printer connection. This command presents a <u>Print Setup dialog box</u>, where you specify the printer and its connection.

### **Print Setup dialog box**

The following options allow you to select the destination printer and its connection.

#### Printer

Select the printer you want to use. Choose the Default Printer; or choose the Specific Printer option and select one of the current installed printers shown in the box. You install printers and configure ports using the Windows Control Panel.

#### Orientation

Choose Portrait or Landscape.

#### **Paper Size**

Select the size of paper that the document is to be printed on.

#### **Paper Source**

Some printers offer multiple trays for different paper sources. Specify the tray here.

#### **Options**

Displays a dialog box where you can make additional choices about printing, specific to the type of printer you have selected.

#### Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.
