Search Result List

• Sending files to Delphi

Expression

Enter the expression, or text, you want to search for.

Directory

Specify the directory you want to start the search in. You may also enable <u>searching in sub-</u><u>directories</u>.

Help

The help menu allows you to open the help file, obtain order information, enter the registration number, and see the *About* dialog.

File Mask

Enter a MS-DOS file mask specifying the files you want to include in the search.

File

Exit the program.

Search

Start and stop a search. <u>Send files to Delphi</u>.

Case sensitive search

Enable this option to make the search case sensitive (ex. TEST <> test).

Use regular expressions

Enable this option to allow the use of *regular expressions*. See the <u>Delphi manual</u> for more information.

Search sub-directories

Enable this option to search for files in all sub-directories of the specified <u>directory</u>.

Clear list before search

Eanble this option to automatically clear the "Search result list" every time you begin a new search.

Activate search dialog

Enable this option to automatically scroll the file to the top and open the search dialog every time you <u>send a file to Delphi</u>.

Sending files to Delphi

You can double click on a file in the "Search result list", or press **CTRL-S**, to send the selected file to Delphi. If you enabled <u>Activate search dialog</u>, Delphi will scroll to the top of the file and open with search dialog.
