# Adding a New Entry

I. If their are no other Entries

## a. **Restart Program**

- b. <u>R</u>ecords > <u>D</u>ata Entry
- c. Enter Information
- d. <u>R</u>ecords > <u>U</u>pdate
- II. If you have existing Entries
  - a. <u>R</u>ecords > <u>D</u>ata Entry
  - b. Enter Information
  - c. <u>R</u>ecords > <u>U</u>pdate

- a. <u>V</u>iew > E<u>d</u>it
- b. Use Navigation Buttons to find Entry
- c. Edit Information
- d. <u>R</u>ecords > <u>U</u>pdate

# **Copying and Pasting**

Their are several ways to copy information from The Internet Navigator to your terminal program.

#### Copying

I. You may uses the Copy Internet Address Button to copy only the Internet address to the clipboard and then past it to you program.

II. You may highlight the information you want to copy and the use the Windows Hot Keys Ctrl+C to copy the information to the clipboard and then past the information your terminal program.

III. Finally you may highlight the information and the click  $\underline{E}$ dit >  $\underline{C}$ opy to copy information to the clipboard and then past the information to your terminal program.

#### Pasting

I. You may uses the Past Internet Address Button to past information to the Internet address only.

II. You may use the Windows Hot Keys Ctrl+V to past information to any section of he Internet Navigator.

III. Finally you may click <u>E</u>dit > <u>P</u>ast to past information to any location in The Internet Navigator Program.

Note: The Buttons Copy Internet Address Only and Past Internet Address Only are intended as Hot Keys and only copy and past to the Internet address Field even without it being highlighted.

# Float On/Off

The ability to float on top of all windows programs allows The Internet Navigator to be used with any terminal program available.

To turn the float option on and off *Press* <u>W</u>indow > <u>T</u>op Most Window.

# **Sorting Information**

Sorting information is one of The Internet Navigators strong points. When using the **View** commands The Internet Navigator is sorts in alphabetical order the **Short Description Field** to make information easier to find. During this time information can not be edited however it can be copied.
