

## What is a CD\_CAT?

CD\_CAT is an application for keeping information about CD library, fast searching required files and comparing contain of a CD with CDs in library. Graphic and Windows Explorer like interface makes this processes very easy.

## How to use?

- **Add new disk into library.**

To add new disk into library click 'File' item on menu, then select 'Add new entry'. After this, select one or more disks from drive list and click button 'OK'.

Tip:

You may change predefined image for new CD by clicking right mouse button on disk's list.

- **Delete disk from library.**

To delete disk entry from library select disk and click menu item 'Edit', then 'Delete entry' or click right mouse button on view of disk's tree content and select 'Delete'.

- **View entry properties and edit description.**

On left or right side of main screen select interesting entry and click right mouse button and then select 'Properties'. In appeared dialog box you can see properties of entry and edit entry description. To save changes to entry description click 'OK' button.

- **Find files.**

To find files select menu item 'Tools' and then 'Find'. In dialog box fill fields for search restrict areas. After this click 'Find' button. List with found entries will appear on window bottom and status bar will contain number of found entries.

- **Find matches.**

To find matches select menu item 'Tools' and then 'Find matches'. In dialog box fill fields defining which directory you want to compare with contain of library and check boxes for search restrict areas. After executing your query you may see found matches in defined directory in the list above. Selecting entries from this list will change contain of list below. The list below will show matches in library corresponding to the selected entries from the above list.

- **Images setup.**

To setup images for entries select menu item 'Tools' and then 'Images setup'. In appeared dialog box you may add, edit, and delete images and assign them to defined group with one or more extensions.

Warning:

Images used for library entries can not be deleted.

- **Setup list of info files.**

To setup info files for entries select menu item 'Tools' and then 'Info files setup'. In appeared dialog box you may edit list of names of description files. In this list you may use full file names or file masks, e.g. '\*.nfo'.
