

## Welcome to the Netscape Cache Explorer



Easy offline-access to all Web pages that have been cached by Netscape Navigator. Save costs on telephone and provider charges and surf offline.

Before using this software, please read the **License Agreement**.

See the section **Ordering Information** for obtaining a registered version of this software.

### **Quick Overview**

NSCE works directly on the Navigator's Cache Database. Lengthy copying of the cache contents is not necessary to view pages offline.

NSCE uses a Windows Explorer-like presentation to display the Cache. Just double-click on a document to view it within the Navigator. NSCE configures the Navigator automatically to let you follow links to existing documents without any problems.

Organizing functions like intelligent domain sorting, hiding and deleting documents, helps you to keep track of important things in the browser cache universe.

With the integrated full text search you are able to find any document you want.

Web pages that you may find important can easily be extracted from the cache to your file system. NSCE will follow automatically all links to referenced documents and saves them together with those you have selected.

Last but not least: You can even import the MS Internet Explorer Cache, or another Netscape Cache into the current Netscape cache.

**NSCE supports the 32bit versions of Netscape Navigator v2, v3, and Netscape Communicator v4.0x and v4.5x.**

NSCE is designed to work on Windows 95, Windows 98, and Windows NT 4.0.

### **How to install the Netscape Cache Explorer**

If you have received or downloaded the self-installing archive NSCE@.EXE (or NSCEG@.EXE for the German version):

- 1 Double-click NSCE@.EXE to execute it.
- 2 The setup program runs automatically and guides you through the rest of the installation process.

If you have received or downloaded the zipped archive NSCE.ZIP (or NSCEG.ZIP for the German version):

- 1 Create a new folder as working directory.
- 2 Use a archive utility such as WinZip to unzip the archive to this folder. This will create several new files.
- 3 Double-click the file SETUP.EXE to execute it.
- 4 Setup guides you through the rest of the installation process.

### **To remove Netscape Cache Explorer from your computer:**

- 1 Open the Control Panel (on the Start menu choose Settings, Control Panel).
- 2 Double-click the icon "Add/Remove programs".
- 3 Search in the list for the item "Netscape Cache Explorer" and double-click it.
- 4 Setup will remove all accompanying files.

### **Using NSCE with the various versions of Netscape Navigator/Communicator**

If you encounter problems when running NSCE the first time, or after you have upgraded to a newer version of Netscape, click **Preferences** on the **Tools** menu and verify the following:

- The **Netscape Version** setting must match the version you want to use. Please note that even version **v4.0x** and **v4.5x** must be handled different.
- If you have multiple versions of Netscape installed, enter the complete path to the netscape.exe you want to use for each version.
- Unlike the Communicator v4, the stand-alone Navigator v4 cannot be switched into offline mode. Although it is not recommended to use NSCE with the stand-alone version, you can do so, if you manually disable document verification.

**QuickView does not work**

You have to install QuickView from your Windows 95 CD in order to use it with NSCE. To view popular web file formats (e.g. GIF, JPG), you should consider to use a QuickView extension such as QuickView Plus from Inso.

### Some pages are not cached

- Some pages contain a nocache-pragma which prevents them from being cached.
- When closing Netscape v3 or v4, it discards all files from the cache which do not have a **Last Modification Date**. Some web servers do not provide this info, or not for all files. On our web site at <http://www.mwso.com/>, you will find a patch for Netscape that will solve the problem.
- There are some tools which change the Netscape cache size to 0 without asking the user for permission to do so, or which otherwise damage the Netscape cache. A known example is a tool called **NetSonic**. See **Do Not Use NetSonic** for a solution.

**Do not use NetSonic!**

There are some tools which change the Netscape cache size to 0 without asking the user for permission to do so, or which otherwise damage the Netscape cache. A known example is a tool called **NetSonic**.

As a result Netscape is no longer able to cache files, or it can cache only a few one. Depending on the version of NetSonic, the cache index may still list entries, but there are no real files associated with it.

**To repair your cache:**

- Completely uninstall NetSonic
- Within Netscape, completely clear your disk cache, and set its size to an appropriate value.
- Close Netscape to ensure that the settings will take effect (necessary due to a Netscape bug).

**No valid cache directory has been found (error message)**

- After installation, or after creating a new user profile, Netscape may have not yet created a cache database. Within Netscape, type "about:cache" into the address field, or browse online to get some pages cached.
- You may have upgraded your Netscape Navigator. See **NSCE and the various versions of Netscape Navigator/Communicator** for a solution.

### **Netscape connects to the Internet instead of displaying a page offline**

- You may have installed multiple versions of Netscape, and NSCE has launched the wrong one. Verify your NSCE Preferences as described in **NSCE and the various versions of Netscape Navigator/Communicator**.
- You are using a beta version of Netscape Communicator. NSCE needs at least the Final Release v4.01 of Netscape Communicator. Netscape Navigator v2 and v3 are also supported.
- Your Netscape Communicator is switched to Online Mode. Within the Communicator, switch back to Offline Mode by selecting **Go Offline** from the **File** menu.
- The page you want to view offline has an expiration date set. Netscape refuses to display such pages from the cache.

**To extract documents from the cache**

- 1 In Cache Explorer, select the document or multiple documents you want to save.
- 2 On the **File** menu, click **Save As** and follow the instructions on your screen.

**Tips**

It is sufficient to select only one file (e.g. the home page of a web site). All referenced files will be automatically saved together with the one you have selected.

Of course, you can change this behavior in the **Save As Dialog Box**.

**To hide documents of a certain type**

- On the **View** menu, check the **Text Only** entry if you want only HTML or plain text documents to be displayed.
- Check the **Web Pages Only** entry if you want only documents whose URL starts with the protocol prefix **http:** or **https:** to be displayed.

**Tips**

- Check the **Display All** entry to display all documents including those you have hidden individually.
- You may use the Toolbar buttons instead of the menu commands.

**To hide a document or domain folder**

- 1 Select the documents or the domain folder you want to hide.
- 2 On the **File** menu, click **Hide**.

**Tips**

- To display all documents including those you have hidden individually check the **Display All** entry on the **View** menu.
- To unhide all individually hidden items on the fly, select **Unhide All** from the **Tools** menu.
- You may use the Toolbar buttons instead of the menu commands.

### **Sorting documents**

▶ On the **View** Menu, point to **Sort Documents**, then select the column by which the documents should be sorted.

#### **Tips**

- You may also click on the column headers in the right window pane. A small arrow indicates by which column the documents are sorted.
- If you click a second time on a column which already contains the arrow, the sort direction changes from ascending to descending and vice versa.

### Sorting domains

▶ On the **View** Menu, point to **Sort Domains**, then select either **Alphabetically**, **Hierarchically**, or **by Date** (of last access).

#### Tips

Hierarchical sorting gives you a better overview about domain names that belong together. Consider three domains, named:

ftp.sample.com  
home.sample.com  
www.sample.com.

When sorted alphabetically, they are scattered on the domain tree. Hierarchical sort keeps them together:

com.sample.ftp  
com.sample.home  
com.sample.www

**To find text in domain name, URL, or document title**

- ▶ On the **Edit** menu, click **Find** and follow the instructions on your screen.

**Tips**

- To find subsequent occurrences of the text you have already specified, press the F3 key.
- You may use the Toolbar buttons instead of the menu commands.



### **To search for text in the contents of documents**

- ▶ On the **Tools** menu, click **Search Document Contents** and follow the instructions on your screen.

#### **Tips**

- After the search is completed, you will find a new main folder called Search Results in the domain tree.
- You may use the Toolbar buttons instead of the menu commands.
- You can cancel a search by clicking the Search button again.



**To view a cached document offline with your browser**

- 1 In Cache Explorer, locate the document you want to view.
- 2 Double-click on the document.

**Tips**

- You may set Cache Explorer's preferences to auto-adjust the browser configuration for offline-viewing. To do this, click **Preferences** on the **Tools** menu and follow the instructions on your screen.
- To display a preview of the selected document, click **Quick View** on the **File** menu.
- To view or edit the selected document with **another application**, drag it on a window or an icon of the application you want to use.

**To delete one or more documents or an entire domain**

- 1 In Cache Explorer, select the items you want to delete.
- 2 On the **File** menu, click **Delete**.

Items are deleted immediately. You are prompted to confirm the operation, because it cannot be undone. You may use the Toolbar buttons instead of the menu commands.

**To import the cache contents from MS Internet Explorer**

- 1 On the **Tools** menu, click **Import MSIE Cache**.
- 2 You are prompted to confirm the operation.

NSCE copies all files from IE's cache directory into the Netscape cache currently used. If a file (URL) already exists within the current cache, it will be overwritten only if the IE cache contains a newer version.

**Tips**

- Make sure, you have **enough room** to add the imported items. Check your cache settings within Netscape.

### **To import the contents from another Netscape Cache**

- 1 On the **Tools** menu, click **Import another Netscape Cache**.
- 2 Locate the cache directory you want to import.

NSCE copies all files from the selected cache directory into the cache currently used. If a file (URL) already exists within the current, it will be overwritten only with a newer version.

### **Tips**

- Although Netscape does not allow you to share a single cache between Netscape v3.x, v4.0x and v4.5x, you can safely import one cache version into another. NSCE will convert all items into the appropriate format.
- Make sure, you have **enough room** to add the imported items. Check your cache settings within Netscape.



Follows all links to text documents residing in the same domain as the selected document and saves them.



Follows all links to text documents not residing in the same domain as the selected document and saves them.

Changes all links to text documents not found in the cache so that they point to a default file created by the Cache Explorer.

If you leave this field unchecked, all broken links refer to the original location of the file.

Follows all links to images and media files residing in the same domain as the selected document and saves them.

Follows all links to images and media files not residing in the same domain as the selected document and saves them.

Changes all links to images and media files not found in the cache so that they point to a default file created by the Cache Explorer. Less important links (e.g. to a background sound file) are removed if they cannot be solved. If you leave this field unchecked, all broken links refer to the original location of the file.

Uses MS-DOS compatible short file names instead of long file names.

Shows the icon for the file you are looking at.

Displays the title or the name of the file.



Displays the complete name and location of the file.

Displays the MIME type of the file.

Displays the local name of the file in the Cache Directory.

Displays the size of the file.

Displays the date that the file was last modified.

Displays the date that you have last accessed the file.

Displays the date that the information provided in this file will expire.

Lets you walk through all files that you have selected to display properties for.



Provides a space for you to enter the text you want to find.

Searches for the next occurrence of the text you have specified.

Searches in the domain names.

Searches in the URL's.

Searches in the document titles.

Provides a space for you to enter words to search for. You may separate multiple words by a space.  
Only documents that contains all words you have specified are displayed in the result list.

Searches through all documents within the Cache.

Searches in the currently selected folder only.



Searches in the currently selected documents only.

Starts the search.


Provides a place for you to type the location and filename of the Web Browser.  
You may leave this field blank to cause Cache Explorer using the default settings.

Click this to browse through folders to find the file you want.

**Save As Dialog Box**

Extracts the selected file (and optionally all referenced files) from the browser cache to your file system.

If you have selected a single file, you may change the suggested name to another name of your choice. If you have selected multiple files, the Cache Explorer generates appropriate file names automatically.

For Help on a dialog item, click  at the top of the dialog box, and then click the item.



Check this field to let the Cache Explorer adjust your browser settings for offline-viewing automatically.  
This prevents your browser from verifying the document state and attempting to connect to the Internet.

Check this to automatically reset all changes that have been made for offline-viewing when closing Cache Explorer.



Enables you to select the preferred user profile for Netscape Communicator.

Available items are

- (Current)  
The default user profile as currently used by Netscape Communicator.
- Named items  
List of defined user profiles for Netscape Communicator.

Provides a place for you to type the location of the Cache Directory.

You may leave this field blank to cause Cache Explorer using the default settings.

Click this to browse through folders to find the Cache Directory.

Enables you to select the version of Netscape Communicator or Navigator you are using.

If you have multiple versions installed, enter the correct netscape.exe location for each of them in the field below. Otherwise NSCE may launch the wrong version.
