#### 1.2 Yawgmoth Demon

Yawgmoth Demon:

- As errata to the Chronicles version of this card, the Demon becomes tapped whether or not the damage is prevented. [Duelist Magazine #7, Page 101]
- As errata to the Antiquities version of this card, it should be read as "Flying, first strike. Sacrifice an artifact during your upkeep or Yawgmoth Demon becomes tapped and deals 2 damage to you." [Duelist Magazine #4, Page 138]
- The sacrificing of an artifact is not mandatory. You can choose not to sacrifice an artifact but will pay the consequences. [Aahz 11/02/94]

### 1.3 Ydwen Efreet

Ydwen Efreet:

As errata, the card should read "If Ydwen Efreet is assigned to block, flip a coin; opponent calls heads or tails while coin is in the air. If the

flip ends up in opponent's favor, Ydwen Efreet cannot block this turn." [WotC Rules Team 09/22/95]

- The coin flip occurs at the end of the Declare Blockers step of the attack. [WotC Rules Team 09/22/95]
- If the coin flip prevents the Efreet from blocking, you cannot put up a different blocker instead. [Arab FAQ 01/05/94]
- In multiplayer games you can pick a different opposing player to call the coin toss each time it is used. [Duelist Magazine #4, Page 64]
